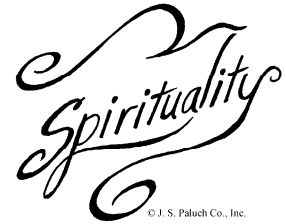

Next Sunday's "Spirituality for Busy People" Seminar

Two of the Greatest Spiritual Guides of all time:
St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross

February 14, 4:00-6:00 PM
Parish Activity Center

Led by Fr. Kevin Joyce Ph.D., Pastor



In last month's seminar on St. Ignatius of Loyola, we saw that the ultimate purpose of the Ignatian *Spiritual Exercises* is to bring Christians to a point where they may live in the constant presence of God and work under the exclusive guidance of God's Spirit, whatever their vocation or life style. Ignatius kept his contemplative ideal united with action in the world. This unique combination of contemplation with an apostolic orientation made great men of action out of great contemplatives.

St. Teresa of Avila (d. 1582) and St. John of the Cross (d. 1591) were heavily influenced by Jesuits, and combined the Ignatian ideal of deep prayer supporting dynamic action in the world on behalf of the Gospel.

St. Teresa's contemporaries perceived her as an extrovert, cheerful, friendly, a good conversationalist, and attractive. She was known as a woman of courage and passion for spiritual adventure. She became the second most influential woman in Christian history, thanks to her influential writings such as *The Interior Castle*.

St. John of the Cross, St. Teresa's friend and collaborator in the reform of monasticism and the Catholic Church in 16th century Spain is considered one of the one of the most eminent poets of the Spanish language as well as the author of profound spiritual books, the most famous of which is *The Dark Night*.

Our seminar will present the stages of the spiritual journey according to St. Teresa (the "Seven Mansions") and St. John's teachings concerning the "dark night of the soul" that so many spiritual seekers pass through.

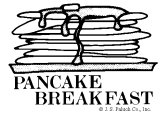

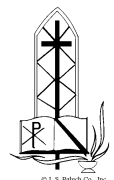
