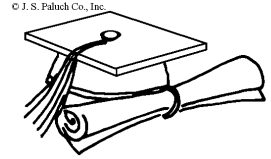

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Fr. Kevin's message to St. Lucy School Graduates

At graduations, we often hear speakers tell the graduates: "You are the future." At Baccalaureate Masses priests regularly tell the graduates, "You are the church of tomorrow." I don't really like either one of those statements. Instead I would say, "You are the Church of today. The Holy Spirit is at work in and through you now. Jesus is expecting great things of you at this time of your life."



This is the message we heard in the Gospel chosen for today's Mass, taken from the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus says, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light shine before all, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Heavenly Father."

This Gospel passage explains why St. Lucy School exists. St. Lucy's parents donate thousands of hours to the school. The wider parish community spends a lot of money supporting St. Lucy School because we want to pass on our faith in Jesus and in the Catholic Church in as deep a way as possible to our children. We believe that Jesus has the best of all possible plans for humanity, and that is what our graduates today have been exposed to over the past nine years at St. Lucy's. Jesus calls himself "the light of the world," and it's very striking that he uses the same phrase to describe us who are his disciples: "You are the light of the world. Let your light shine before all."

Graduates, you have already been called to serve the Christ through your Baptism, and in the next year or two you will be further empowered by the Holy Spirit through the sacrament of Confirmation. God has a plan for each one of you. One of your most important prayers each day should be, "Lord, please show me what you want me to do – today and in the future. Lord, please give me the strength to carry out your will this day and each day." If each of you says this prayer from the heart, you are going to have a glorious future. You are going to do great things for the world because you will be following the one who is the light of the world.

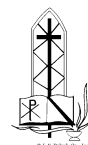
