**Parish Financial Results –
First three quarters to March 20, 2010**

The deficit for the first three quarters of the current fiscal year which runs from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010 was \$56,000. We are on track to exit the year with a slightly lower deficit than the \$90,000 budgeted for the year. The reasons for the improvement are: Sunday and Holy Day Offerings for the year are \$13,000 higher than budgeted, we received Annual Diocesan Appeal and Capital Campaign rebates of \$37,000 , and pastoral, administrative, catechetical, liturgy and youth expenses were kept at or below budget. We would like to thank all of you who answered our call to help reduce our budget deficit, and we count on your continued prayers and support.
