Dear Parishioners,

In our second reading this week, we hear about the nature of hope, which is a God-given anticipation of good. This reading calls to mind a shift, a forward-movement of bringing hope into the world, and it also speaks to the gift of faith that accompanies those on that mighty journey. "Hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." Fifth Sunday Collection**

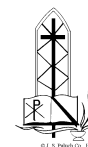
