The Pastoral Council focuses on the most critical matters facing St. Lucy Parish and provides guidance to the Pastor. The role of the Council is pastoral and consultative, not administrative. Some of the things we do include:

- studying life in the parish, including interaction among parishioners and ministries;
- evaluating how the parish is achieving its goals; and
- recommending policies that will cause the faith life of the parish to come alive.

This past year we focused on opportunities for involving the youth in different ministries, developing stewardship, and encouraging openness and connection between our English- and Spanish-speaking communities. It was also a big year welcoming Fr. Kevin as the new pastor.

The Council is now tasked with cultivating our group to develop long-range goals that will help St. Lucy Parish fulfill its mission. 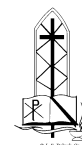
