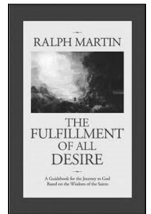


Why are some Christians bored and apathetic in their practice of the faith?

SABOREA LA EXPERIENCIA

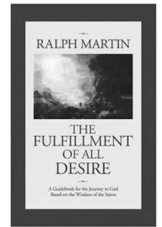
