Next Saturday, August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Catholic Church. Normally this great celebration is a Holy Day of Obligation, but because the Solemnity is on a Saturday, the Bishops of the United States have lifted this obligation. We will celebrate the Solemnity at the scheduled 8:00 a.m. Mass on Saturday.

This Solemnity of the Assumption and topic of dispensation should raise the question about what the meaning of a holy day of obligation is within the Roman Catholic Church and also what our obligations are in general as follows of Jesus in the Catholic tradition. For space purpose we will only tackle the first topic.

The Church reminds us that holy days are given to us to help us focus on the mystery of God's presence in our life with special emphasis on particular actions, such as the Assumption. Believe it or not, each Sunday and eight (8) other solemnities are holy days where we, as faithful Catholics, are called to spend time in prayer (going to Mass) and refrain, if possible, from engaging in work or activities that lessen our ability to worship God.

In other words, on a holy day of obligation, we should: 1. Go to Mass. 2. Take time in contemplating the mystery of our faith. 3. Pray.

El próximo Sábado, 15 de agosto es la Solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María en la Iglesia Católica. Normalmente esta gran fiesta es un día de obligación, pero porque la solemnidad cae en un sábado, los Obispos de los Estados Unidos han levantado esta obligación. Vamos a celebrar la solemnidad en la Misa de las 8 am en Inglés.

La Solemnidad de la Asunción y el tema de dispensación deben plantear la pregunta sobre cuál es el significado de un día de obligación dentro de la Iglesia Católica Romana y también lo que son nuestras obligaciones, en general, en la tradición católica. Por razones de que hay poco espacio, sólo abordaremos el primer tema.

La Iglesia nos recuerda que los días santos se nos dan para ayudarnos a concentrarnos en el misterio de la presencia de Dios en nuestra vida, con especial énfasis en las acciones particulares, como es la Asunción. Aunque creas o no, cada domingo y las ocho (8) otras solemnidades son días sagrados y para nosotros, como fieles católicos, estamos llamados a pasar tiempo en la oración (ir a misa) y abstenerse, si es posible, del trabajo o actividades que disminuyen nuestra capacidad para adorar a Dios. En otras palabras, en un día de obligación, debemos: 1. Ir a Misa. 2. Tomar tiempo para contemplar el misterio de nuestra fe. 3. Orar.



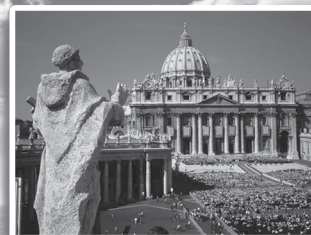
