Welcome Fr. Mark

Please join us in extending a warm welcome to Fr. Mark as he joins St. Lucy Parish as our new Pastor this weekend.



Father Mark Arnzen grew up in Cottonwood, Idaho, a small German-Catholic community. He was the fourth child of nine. After graduating from high school, he served four years in the United States Marine Corps, then moved to the Bay Area to study philosophy and German at Holy Names College in Oakland. With "no particular plan in mind" after graduation, Arnzen moved to northern New Mexico and spent two years teaching at St. Bonaventure School and Mission on the Navajo Indian reservation. Enjoying the life of a teacher and the interplay with students, Father Mark returned to Holy Names College and earned a teaching credential. He then taught sixth grade for six years at St. Lawrence The Martyr School in Santa Clara. During this time he began to discern a call to the priesthood. "God was patient with me," he said. In response, Arnzen entered St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park. As part of his study for ordination, he spent 2002-03 as a pastoral year student assigned to St. Catherine in Morgan Hill. In 2005, he was ordained by Bishop McGrath of the Diocese of San Jose and assigned as Parochial Vicar at St. Martin of Tours Church in San Jose. He also spent one year serving Holy Spirit Church in San Jose's Almaden Valley for one year.

In 2009, he returned to St. Catherine Church in Morgan Hill. He served as their Pastor for the last 6 years.

You are all invited to attend a welcoming reception in his honor after each Mass next weekend, July 11/12. This will give you an opportunity to say hello and welcome Fr. Mark to our parish.



"Training" Masses in four consecutive weekends - June 27/28 to July 18/19

Do you know that there are 4 distinct parts in a Roman Catholic Mass? They are: Introductory rite, liturgy of the word, liturgy of the Eucharist, and the concluding rite.

Starting on June 27/28 weekend, we will begin a 4 part "education" on the Mass as the source and summit of our Christian lives. For the next four weeks, during the homily, we will learn more about:

1. Introductory rite - on June 27/28
2. Liturgy of the word - on July 4/5
3. Liturgy of the Eucharist - on July 11/12
4. The concluding rite - on July 18/19

Hopefully this will allow us to get a deeper appreciation of the Mass as a weekly life changing experience.

Bienvenido Padre Mark

Por favor, ayúdenos en darle una cálida bienvenida al Padre Mark que comienza a servir como Párroco de la Parroquia de Santa Lucia este fin de semana.

El Padre Marcos Arnzen creció en Cottonwood, Idaho, una pequeña comunidad alemana-católica. Fue el cuarto hijo de nueve. Después de graduarse de la escuela high school, sirvió como soldado en el Marine Corps de los Estados Unidos por cuatro años, y luego se mudó a la zona de la bahía para estudiar filosofía y alemán en Holy Names College en Oakland. Con "ningún plan en mente", después de su graduación, Arnzen se mudó al norte de Nuevo México y pasó dos años enseñando en la Escuela y Misión de St. Bonaventure en la reserva de Indios Navajo. Disfrutó tanto su puesto como maestro y la interacción con los estudiantes, que decidió regresar a Holy Names College para obtener su una credencial de enseñanza. Luego enseñó sexto grado durante seis años en la Escuela de St. Lawrence The Martyr, en Santa Clara. Durante este tiempo él comenzó a discernir la llamada al sacerdocio. "Dios fue paciente conmigo", dijo. En respuesta, Arnzen entró al Seminario de San Patricio en Menlo Park. Como parte de su estudio para la ordenación, pasó el año 2002-03 como estudiante pastoral asignado a St. Catherine en Morgan Hill. En 2005, fue ordenado por el Obispo McGrath de la Diócesis de San José y asignado como Vicario Parroquial en St. Martin of Tours en San José. También pasó un año sirviendo en Holy Spirit en Almaden de San José. En 2009, regresó a la Iglesia de St. Catherine en Morgan Hill como su Párroco. Allí, se desempeñó como su Párroco durante los últimos 6 años.

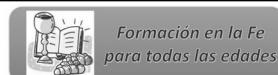
LEGION DE MARIA – CURIA HISPANA

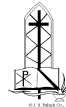

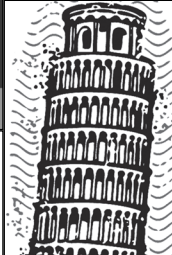

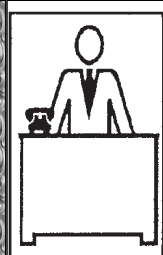
