This weekend we celebrate what is called "Good Shepherd Sunday" which falls on the 4th Sunday of Easter each year. We hear the in Gospel Jesus is the "Good Shepherd" and the Catholic Church reminds us that each priest, in the apostolic tradition, is called to follow as a good shepherd in the footsteps of Jesus.

The calling and command to follow Jesus is important in each priests mission and ministry in serving God's holy people. For each priest who has served at any parish you have attended, celebrated the Sacraments with your family or has cared for a person you have known, he has been called to seek and serve Jesus in his brothers and sisters. This is a challenge requiring deep prayer in uniting his life to the life of Jesus. Fr. Paul Galot, SJ writes, "The shepherd guides the community and ensures unity. Because this pastoral mission is ontologically grounded and linked to an indelibly sacramental character, it can be exercised with greater continuity and efficacy." This is found in a call to holiness discovered in an ongoing fruitful and personal relationship with Jesus discovered in the priests relationship with his community. (Continued on page 5...)
