“Jesus didn't leave us a lot of rituals. He left us his Word and left us one ritual, the Eucharist. He refers to other rituals such as baptism, and other parts of the Christian scriptures refer to the laying on of hands, to the confessing of sins, and to various kinds of anointing with oil, but Jesus, himself, left us only his Word and the Eucharist.” (p 19 Our One Great Act of Fidelity)

Fr. Ronald Rolheiser, OMI reminds us of the centrality of the Eucharist in our Catholic faith. It is what forms us into community, just as the meal around the table helps to form the family into a community of love and blessing. Jesus left us His Body and Blood, His Soul and Divinity; Jesus left us his very Self as a sign of love.

This weekend (and for the next few weekends) our parish community gathers around the altar with many families who will share with their children the Eucharist for the first time in Holy Communion. Whether it is at special Masses on Saturday or part of our Sunday Mass it is a time of celebration and blessing in so many ways for our Catholic Church. (Continued on page 5...)

Much like Easter our routines of Mass will, in some cases, be interrupted by these special blessings we will receive in participating in the growing life of the Church. 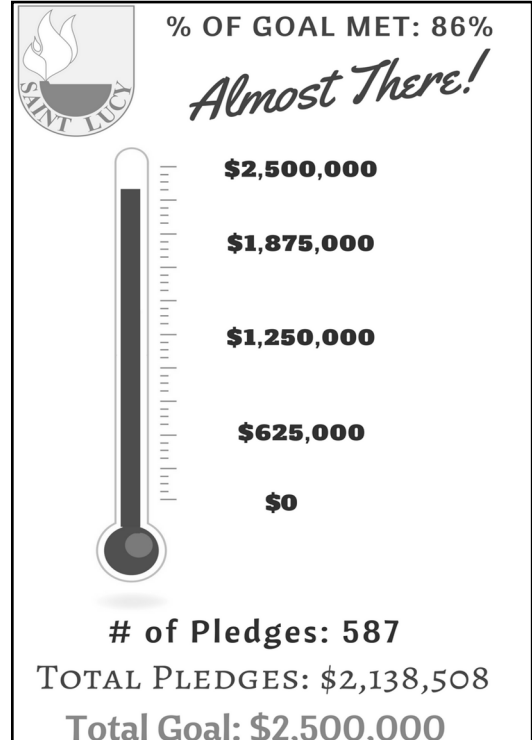

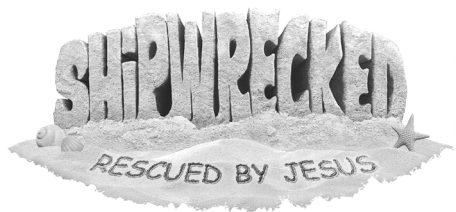

For five days teens (graduated 8th graders to graduated 12th graders) experience and encounter the love of God by means of Catholic catechesis creating lasting friendships. The goal of DYR is to gather and empower teen participants to live fully the gospel of Jesus Christ, develop their Catholic identity and instill a zeal for the New Evangelization. Attendees can look forward to Daily Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, daily workshops and small group dialogues to provide opportunities to encounter Christ and the beauty of the Catholic faith. Recreational times and activities are available throughout the day for teens to unwind and have an unforgettable time (e.g. swim, art, games, music, messy game, challenges, etc.)

El Retiro Diocesano de la Juventud (DYR) es un retiro anual de verano organizado por la Diócesis de San José. Dear Parishioners,

Last week, the St. Lucy School hosted a "State of the School" for our parent community. I began the presentation with a story about the school's journey over the last 64 years. Long ago, the Sisters of Notre Dame opened the school doors in September of 1953. From a new school in an orchard community to a strong, academic school in the heart of Campbell, St. Lucy School has always been a welcoming community for families. The Sisters of Notre Dame followed the words of St. Julie, their foundress, who said, "Teach them what they need to know for life". Our teachers teach the whole child following St. Julie's words, not just the curriculum.

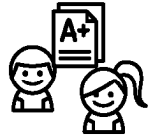
At the State of the School, I informed parents about curriculum changes this year. We have changed over the last 4 years to the Common Core curriculum and we have changed our language arts and math programs to mirror that curriculum. This year as part of our 3 year conversion to Next Generation Science Standards, our Kindergarten class began not only learning science under these standards but for the first time, they have class in our science lab. Now our K-8th graders have transitioned to the NGSS standards where children have more hands on collaborative activities.

How we market our school was discussed. Through print work and Social Media, information about St. Lucy School is shared. New this year, we are on Instagram! It is exciting to learn about daily life at SLS. Interest in St. Lucy School has increased this year. Laurie Galdes, my Admissions Director has given approx. 70 school tours this year. From tours to shadow days to acceptance, it is very exciting to welcome new families to our school community.


