"Delve into the Gospels" is the advice Matthew Kelly shares with us in Chapter 25 of "Rediscover Jesus". This advice is not simply a Lenten practice but a practice of life where the Word of God, Jesus, becomes a constant presence through our acts of intimate love.



The past several weeks we have talked about the three pillars of Lent and this Monday, April 8, we will be asked to fulfill the call of prayer, fasting and almsgiving by entering into sacramental forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If we take time to "delve into the Gospels" we cannot help but notice how Jesus and the ministry he gives to his apostles and his Church revolves around the healing of sin. He commands us most explicitly in the Gospels of John 20:23, Mark 11:25 and Matthew 16:19 but as we get to know the Gospels more intimately we can see how this call to forgiveness and reconciliation is the great call to discipleship where we hear Jesus' own voice speaking to us, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." (Lk 23:34) We also recognize the gift through the command of Jesus in the prayer he gave to us his disciples in the "Our Father". (Continued on page 5...)

"Hurga en los evangelios" es el consejo que Matthew Kelly comparte con nosotros en el capítulo 25 de "Vuelve a Descubrir a Jesús". Este consejo no es simplemente una práctica de Cuaresma, sino una práctica de vida

donde la Palabra de Dios, Jesús, se convierte en una presencia constante a través de nuestros actos de amor íntimo.

Las últimas semanas hemos hablado sobre los tres pilares de la Cuaresma y este lunes 8 de abril, se nos pedirá que cumplamos el llamado de la oración, el ayuno y la caridad al ingresar al perdón sacramental en el Sacramento de Reconciliación. Si nos tomamos el tiempo para "hugarnos en los evangelios", no podemos dejar de notar cómo Jesús y el ministerio que da a sus apóstoles y a su Iglesia giran alrededor de la sanación del pecado. Nos manda de forma más explícita en los Evangelios de Juan 20:23, Marcos 11:25 y Mateo 16:19, pero a medida que conocemos más íntimamente los Evangelios, podemos ver cómo este llamado al perdón y la reconciliación es el gran llamado al discipulado donde escuchamos la propia voz de Jesús que nos habla: "Padre, perdónalos, porque no saben lo que hacen" (Lc 23:34). Encounter Ona

Ona always knew she wanted to be a “shining woman” in her community—and an example to her two young daughters. She studied hard and eventually earned her teaching degree from a university. But in Gaza, jobs are hard to find. Even though Ona had been a good student, she could not find work as a teacher.

“The financial situation was so difficult,” Ona says. “I started to feel hopeless.”

That’s why CRS matches workers with job opportunities. Through CRS, Ona applied for an internship as a teacher and was hired to teach math.

Ona knew she wanted to take full advantage of the opportunity. “I took time to ask questions and learn. I tried to better myself—and become a better teacher.”

Through her internship, Ona gained the confidence and inspiration to branch out on her own. She saved enough money to open a tutoring center. She now helps students of all ages with their math skills, as well as with other subjects. After one month in business, 41 children had visited her center.

“When people encourage you, you start to think in a more creative way,” Ona says.

As she thinks about the future, she thinks of her children. “I hope I can be an example to my daughters. I hope that my daughters can achieve their dreams.”

Un encuentro con Ona

Ona siempre supo que quería ser una "mujer brillante" en su comunidad, y un ejemplo para sus dos hijas pequeñas. Ella estudió mucho y finalmente obtuvo su título de maestra en una universidad. Pero en Gaza, los empleos son difíciles de encontrar. A pesar de que Ona había sido una buena estudiante, no podía encontrar trabajo como maestra.

"La situación financiera era muy difícil", dice Ona. "Empecé a sentirme desesperada".

Es por eso que CRS combina a los trabajadores con las oportunidades de trabajo. A través de CRS, Ona solicitó una pasantía como maestra y fue contratada para enseñar matemáticas.

Ona sabía que quería aprovechar la oportunidad al máximo. "Me tomé el tiempo para hacer preguntas y aprender. Intenté mejorar y convertirme en un mejor maestro".

A través de su pasantía, Ona ganó la confianza y la inspiración para expandirse por su cuenta. Ella ahorró suficiente dinero para abrir un centro de tutoría. Ahora ayuda a estudiantes de todas las edades con sus habilidades matemáticas, así como con otras materias. Después de un mes en el negocio, 41 niños habían visitado su centro.

"Cuando las personas te alientan, empiezas a pensar de una manera más creativa", dice Ona.

Mientras piensa en el futuro, piensa en sus hijos. "Espero poder ser un ejemplo para mis hijas. Espero que mis hijas puedan lograr sus sueños".



SHAKSHOUKA

Makes 4 servings

- 3 T fair trade olive oil
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 7oz can green chilis
- 1 28oz can diced tomatoes
- 1 T ketchup
- 2 t salt
- 4 eggs



SHAKSHOUKA

Rinde 4 porciones

- 3 cucharitas de aceite de oliva de comercio justo
- 1 cebolla picada
- 2 dientes de ajo, picados
- 1 7 oz latas de chiles verdes
- 1 28 oz latas de tomates en cubitos
- 1 salsa de tomate
- 2 t de sal
- 4 huevos


Heat oil in a large pan. Sauté onions and garlic. Add chilis including juice and cook until soft. Add tomatoes, ketchup and salt. Cook tomatoes down to a sauce. Make four holes in the sauce with a spoon. Crack the eggs into the holes and cover until the eggs cook. Leave yolks runny.

Caliente el aceite en una sartén grande. Saltear las cebollas y el ajo. Agregue los chiles con el jugo y cocine hasta que estén suaves. Añadir los tomates, el ketchup y la sal. Cocinar los tomates hasta una salsa. Hacer cuatro agujeros en la salsa con una cuchara. Rompe los huevos en los agujeros y cubra hasta que los huevos se cocinen. Dejen las yemas líquidas.

Dear Parishioners,

Students are excited to experience spring. With warm weather, students are able to go outside and run around. Listening to their happy voices is exciting since the rain has kept them inside. Now that we have glimpses of sunshine, our science teachers are able to plan outside activities too.

In our K-5 science classrooms our students are busy learning about their environment. Our Kindergarteners are planting seeds. They will see new life as their plants blossom closer to Easter. In 1st grade, students are observing vegetable seeds growing and learning to identify their different parts. In 2nd grade, students are learning about changes that occur from heat. In 4th grade, are learning about Motion and Waves. Students will observe wave motion by working with a metal spring and observe how waves are created and their pattern of movement. 5th graders are learning about the basic needs of animals. They are also expanding their understanding of non-living factors. There are many strategies our teachers use to teach the science curriculum: direct instruction, group collaboration, pair sharing and hands on projects are all key to their science growth. Our Jr. High students are focusing on their Science Fair projects. They are now working to prove their hypothesis on projects that range from Biology to Engineering. The projects are due at the beginning of May, when we will host our STREAM Celebration.

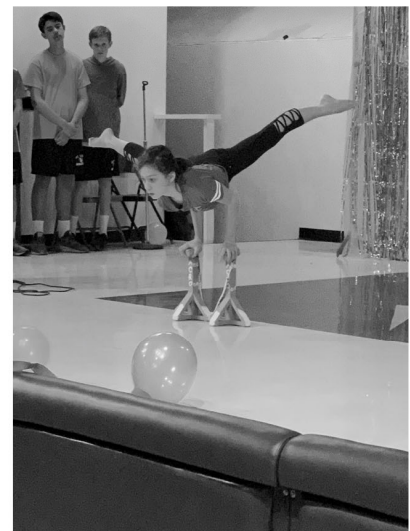
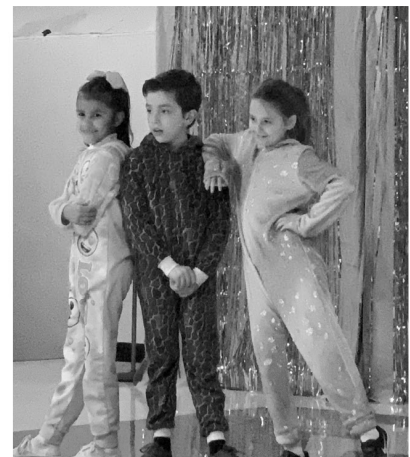

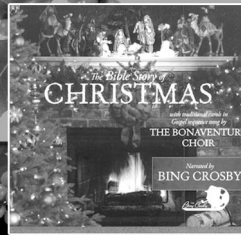
