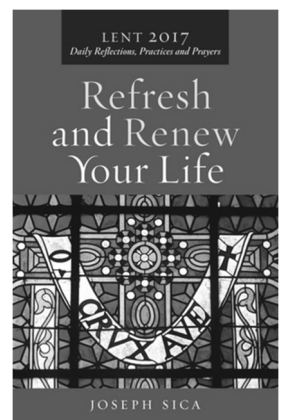


A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

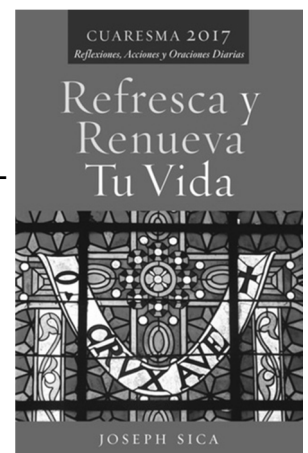

Children's Faith Formation / Formación de Fe para Niños

The Gospel of Matthew (Matthew 21:1-17) tells the story of Jesus' triumphant ride into Jerusalem on the back of a donkey. On Palm Sunday we celebrate this story which marks the beginning of the "Holy Week."

The children in the catechesis have learned about Palm Sunday, the Holy Week and the Paschal Mystery. Also during Lent, they learned how to practice the spiritual pillars of Lent: prayer, fasting and alms-giving.

As we approach to the end of Lent, we have been collecting the CRS Rice Bowl boxes of the children in their classes. If your child still do not return it, please bring the filled boxes to the parish office during office hours. The donations collected will go to hunger and poverty alleviation efforts in the world and in our own community.

As we walk with Jesus through Holy Week, we call to mind the countless men, women and children who even today carry heavy crosses: crosses of hunger, of homelessness, of a lack of resources or security.

We must always remember that Holy Week gives way to Easter; the fast turns into a feast. As we prepare to celebrate Easter joy, it is our responsibility as members of God's one human family to share that joy with everyone, near and far.

El Evangelio de Mateo (Mateo 21: 1-17) cuenta la historia del viaje triunfal de Jesús a Jerusalén montado en un burro. El Domingo de Ramos celebramos esta historia que marca el comienzo de la "Semana Santa".

Los niños de la catequesis han aprendido sobre el Domingo de Ramos, la Semana Santa y el Misterio Pascual. También durante la Cuaresma, aprendieron a practicar los pilares espirituales de la Cuaresma: la oración, el ayuno y la limosna.

A medida que nos acercamos al final de la Cuaresma, hemos estado recogiendo las cajas de CRS Rice Bowl en sus clases. Si su hijo todavía no la devuelve, por favor traiga la caja llena a la oficina parroquial durante las horas de oficina. Las donaciones colectadas se destinarán a los esfuerzos de aliviar el hambre y la pobreza en el mundo y en nuestra propia comunidad.

Mientras caminamos con Jesús a través de la Semana Santa, recordemos a los innumerables hombres, mujeres y niños que aún hoy llevan pesadas cruces: cruces de hambre, falta de vivienda, falta de recursos o seguridad.

Debemos recordar siempre que la Semana Santa da paso a la Pascua; el ayuno se convierte en fiesta. Mientras nos preparamos para celebrar el gozo de Pascua, es nuestra responsabilidad como miembros de una única familia de Dios compartir esa alegría con todos, cerca y lejos.

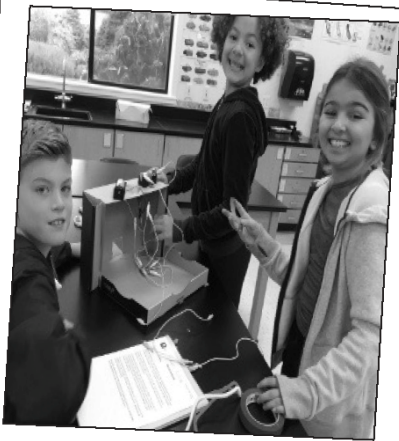
