Saving Water at St. Lucy

“The order of creation demands that a priority be given to those human activities that do not cause irreversible damage to nature, but which instead are woven into the social, cultural, and religious fabric of the different communities. In this way, a sober balance is achieved between consumption and the sustainability of resources.” (Pope Benedict XVI, Message to the Director General of the Food & Agriculture Org.; Celebration of World Food Day, Oct. 16, 2006.)

We at St. Lucy are doing our part to reduce water usage, so you may notice our plants and lawn are a little less green or drier than usual since we have cut back watering frequency.

Outdoor tip: Reduce your lawn irrigation by at least 20%: Depending on your reduction goal, reduce the number of watering days per week and/or reduce the minutes of watering per day. The lawn won't look its best, but it will survive. Indoor tip: Fix leaky toilets and save 30 to 50 gallons per day per toilet. You can also contact the water district for free shower-heads, shower timers, faucet aerators, and toilet flappers and schedule a free “water wise” inspection of your home. Ahorro de agua en Santa Lucía

"El orden de la creación exige que se dé prioridad a aquellas actividades humanas que no causan daños irreversibles a la naturaleza, sino que en su lugar tejen el tejido social, cultural y religioso de las diferentes comunidades. De esta manera, se logra un equilibrio entre el consumo y la sostenibilidad de los recursos". (Benedicto XVI, Mensaje a la Directora General de la Celebración de la Alimentación y la Agricultura; Día Mundial de la Alimentación, 16 de octubre de 2006)

Nosotros en Santa Lucía estamos haciendo nuestra parte para reducir el consumo de agua, por lo que puede observar que nuestras plantas y el césped están un poco menos verdes o secos ya que hemos recortado la frecuencia de riego.

Sugerencia para el Jardín: Puede reducir el riego de césped en al menos un 20%: puede reducir el número de días de riego por semana y/o reducir los minutos de riego por día. El césped no se verá tan bonito pero va a sobrevivir. Sugerencia para los Interiores: Arreglar inodoros con fugas y ahorrar de 30 a 50 galones por día por inodoro. También puede ponerse en contacto con el distrito de agua para programar una inspección gratuita de su casa con sugerencias de cómo reducir su consumo.
