This month our parish is focusing on the first of the Spiritual Works of Mercy, “Instructing the Ignorant.” We, as a church, understand that ignorance in the works of mercy has nothing to do with intelligence; rather it has to do with the “not knowing.” Specifically, it is not knowing the person of Jesus Christ, the faith we are called to follow and the teachings that come from our Church.

We are called through our actions to be attentive to the needs of others, to help all people to understand and see the reality of God’s blessings in the world. The great and small works, which surround us each day, are the tools shared with us to instruct the ignorant.

Matthew Kelly, in his book Rediscover Jesus, in talking about miracles and writes, “*Miracles are radical by their very nature and so we shouldn’t be surprised that they play a central role in Jesus’ ministry. His miracles combined every aspect of his radical nature. But in another sense, his miracles were ordinary. They were simple and practical, like his teachings. They were of real service to people, not just spectacular for the sake of being spectacular.*” (p 90)

Many times people ignorant of God’s generosity think only of the great and spectacular when imagining miracles. Our work, as believers, is to show the small miracles that surround all of us with great joy. To reveal God’s presence in the little details of life and to search out the grace of God as we walk with him in the ways of faith. When you see a miracle today....talk about it! **God bless, Fr. Mark**

Matthew Kelly, en su libro Vuelve a Descubrir a Jesús, al hablar de milagros escribe: "Los milagros son radicales por su naturaleza y no debe sorprendernos que jueguen un papel importante en el ministerio de Jesús. Sus milagros combinan todos los aspectos de Su naturaleza radical. Mas en otro sentido, Sus milagros fueron comunes. Fueron sencillos y prácticos, como Sus enseñanzas. Prestaban un verdadero servicio a la gente, no simplemente espectaculares con el propósito de ser espectacular. (p 88-89)

Muchas veces las personas ignorantes de la generosidad de Dios sólo piensan que los milagros son grandes y espectaculares. Nuestro trabajo, como creyentes, es demostrar los pequeños milagros que nos rodean con gran alegría: para revelar la presencia de Dios en los pequeños detalles de la vida y buscar la gracia de Dios mientras caminamos en los caminos de la fe. ¡Cuando vea un milagro hoy ... anúncielo!

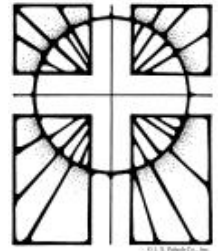

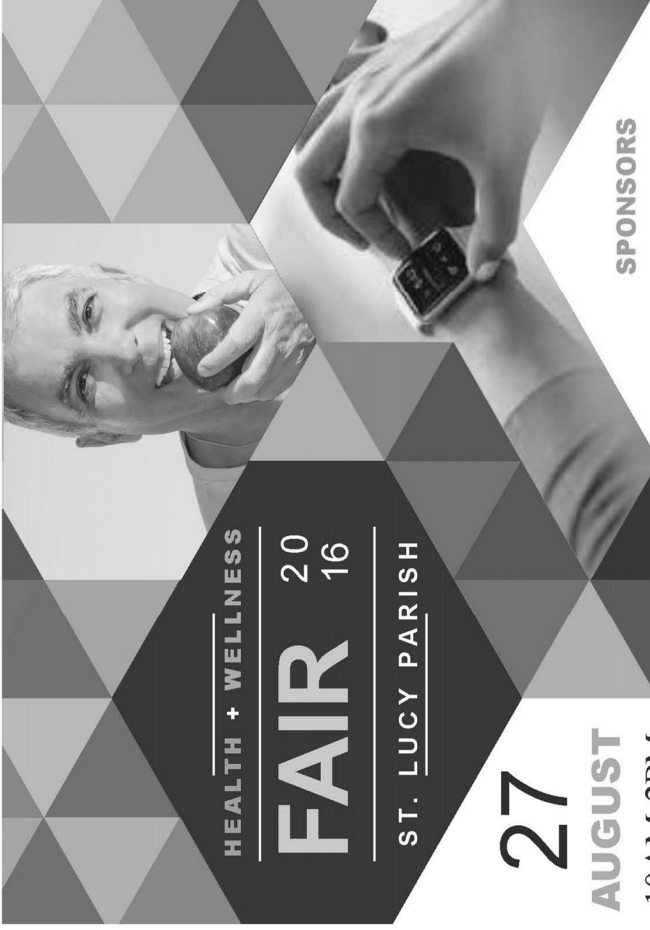
