SVDP/Outreach Corner

Catholic Foundation Grant: The St. Lucy Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul has received a grant of \$3500 from the Catholic Community Foundation of Santa Clara County. Funds for this grant come from endowed funds of the Catholic Community Foundation and matching funds from John M. Sobrato. The funds will be used for our project: Helping the Needy and Homeless.
