- Certificado Bautismal: – Original y reciente y valido por lo menos 6 meses antes del matrimonio, la pareja presentará el certificado de bautizo, y/o primera comunión y confirmación. Si uno de los novios no es católico, tendrá que presentar una carta de afiliación a la religión que pertenece.
- Testimonio Personal: – Los novios llenarán esta forma;
- Testimonio del testigo: – Generalmente esta forma es llenada por un familiar o conocido del novio y de la novia Forma de dispensación: – En caso de que uno de los novios no sea católico, él o ella promete que los hijos serán bautizados y criados como católicos.
- Licencia de Matrimonio:– Deben obtener su Licencia Matrimonial (sino se han casado por el civil); por lo menos un mes antes de la fecha de la boda y deben presentarla el día del ensayo. Si la pareja quiere validar su matrimonio, entonces debe mostrar el certificado de matrimonio.
- Certificado de preparación Matrimonial: Requisito de asistencia al retiro de preparación matrimonial el 13 de Enero 2018 (solo por inscripción)

THE RITE OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION EL RITO DE ACEPTACION DEL RITO DE INICIACION CRISTIANA

Today the St. Lucy's community welcomed and received 13 children and 5 adults in the Order of Catechumens of the Rite of Christian Initiation. These children and adults are preparing to receive their Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) in the Easter Vigil.

The Rite of Acceptance marks their acceptance into the order of catechumens. The candidates expressed and the Church accepted their intention to respond to God's call to follow the way of Christ. Their parents or godparents marked the sign of the cross in the senses praying for them to follow Jesus closer. Also, we prayed that the community becomes their support and example as Jesus' followers.

Please pray for them as they enter in a deeper process of catechesis and spiritual growth.

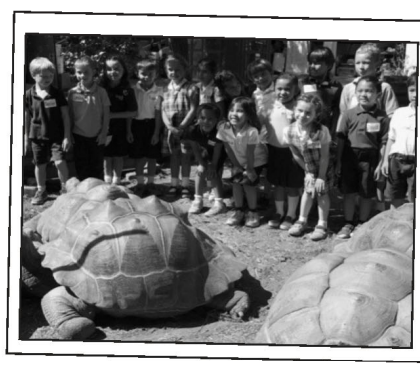

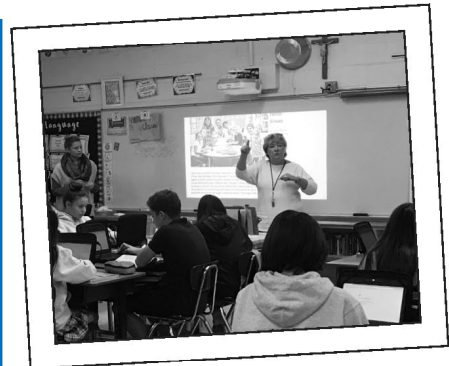

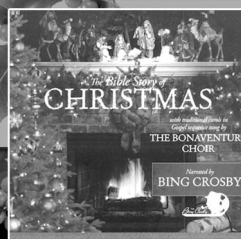
