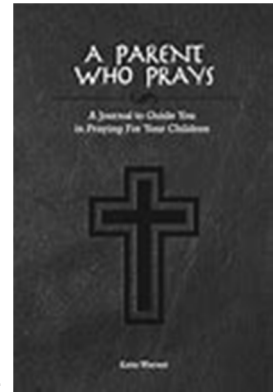

In the same way our sacrifice needs to reflect our spiritual openness to giving to others. If we just give what we deem to be extra, then this giving simply contributes to the "excess" of the season. Our sacrifice must be from the heart and mean we do with a little less so that others may have a little more.

Once more, I would encourage you to continue to focus on **A Parent who Prays** especially during Advent. It is a good time to discuss and pray over the virtue of generosity described below.

Lastly, as we prepare for the Christmas Day celebrations please consider inviting friends and neighbors to Mass. If you are able, please carpool with family and friends. Be patient with the many visitors who will be attending Mass. And please be generous with your parish. Please read about our Capital Campaign and how we plan to worship as a parish during the renovations of the lights in the church beginning in January.

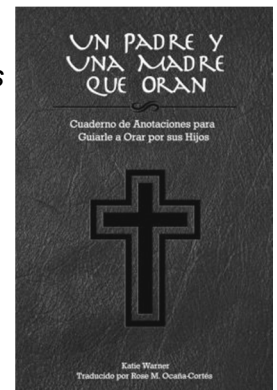

WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

Generosity: Generosity inspires within us the attitude of gratitude, and this gift of gratitude inspires generosity. When we recognize God's generosity to us then our generosity is given freely and with love. (see 2 Cor. 9:11).

Bringing the intention into your family/relationships: Generosity is more about our choices than it is about what we give and receive. It is about sharing our time, talent and treasure by being good stewards of God's gift of life.

Discussion starter: We may ask the questions: How can I be generous with my family during Advent? What are the gifts we can share?

Spiritual Bouquet: Make a list of those things the family discussed and shared and write a thank you note each time you see it in action.

TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN PARA LA ORACIÓN

Generosidad: la generosidad inspira en nosotros la actitud de gratitud, y este don de gratitud inspira la generosidad. Cuando reconocemos la generosidad de Dios hacia nosotros, nuestra generosidad se da libremente y con amor. (ver 2 Cor. 9:11).

We are called to help those who are less fortunate.

The **Christmas Food Box Program** provides food for a complete Christmas dinner. Families who receive Christmas Boxes are from our St. Lucy Parish community or who live within our parish boundaries. Non-perishable food for the Christmas boxes will be collected through **Sunday, December 15th**

All St. Lucy Parishioners are encouraged to bring non-perishable food to Mass and place the food in the baskets at the exits to the Church. **Please check the expiration date before you donate. We cannot use any food that has been opened, spoiled, or damaged or is past its expiration date.** All food donated will be accepted, excluding any home-canned products i.e. preserves, etc. Boxes given to our families are identical except for quantities that are based on family size.

Cranberry sauce - 16 oz. can
Vegetables - 15 oz. can
Fruit - 15 oz. can
Hominy - 6 lb. can

Sugar - 4 or 5 lb. bag

Flour - 5 lb. bag
Rice - 2 lb. bag

Jell-O/Pudding - 3 oz. box
Stuffing - 8-12 oz. box
Dried Mashed Potatoes - 12-16 oz. box
Dried Beans - 2 lb. bag

The Knights of Columbus and a grant from the LDS Bishop's Storehouse will be used for most of the perishables (eggs, butter, ham and turkeys) that are included with the Christmas boxes. To provide funds towards the purchase of the remaining perishables and other food items make checks payable to St. Lucy Conference, St. Vincent de Paul, and leave your check at the Parish Office, put it in a Sunday collection basket or leave at the Office by Monday, Dec. 16th.

Giving Trees have envelopes rather than ornaments this year. Giving Trees are located at the exits of the Church. Each item requested is for those in need who either are members of the St. Lucy Parish, live within our Parish boundaries or who are homeless and come to the Outreach Office for food. Please return your envelopes with the requested items by **Sunday, December 22nd**. Do not put the envelopes with your gifts in the food baskets.

Items requested include gift cards to fast food restaurants, Big 5 Sporting Goods, and grocery stores, funds for bus tokens, rent and utilities and pledges for pantry items to be brought to Mass once a month for three months.

If you want to volunteer to be part of the Christmas program: Call the Outreach Office at 408-378-8086. Leave your name and phone number and what you want to do.

If you are a St. Lucy family that is in need of a Christmas Food Box, sign up at the St. Vincent de Paul/Outreach Office Monday through Friday from 10:00 - 11:45 a.m. Sign-ups end December 13th.

THE ADVENT WREATH

Today, we lit the second candle in the Advent Wreath. Traditionally, each of the four candles in the Advent Wreath have a deeper meaning:

- ◆ The **1st Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Hope with the "Prophet's Candle" reminding us that Jesus is coming.
- ◆ The **2nd Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Faith with the "Bethlehem Candle" reminding us of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.
- ◆ The **3rd Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Joy with the "Shepherd's Candle" reminding us of the Joy the world is experienced at the coming birth of Jesus.
- ◆ The **4th Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Peace with the "Angel's Candle" reminding us of the message of the angels: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."



LA CORONA DE ADVIENTO

Hoy, encendimos la segunda vela en la Corona de Adviento. Tradicionalmente, cada una de las cuatro velas en la corona de Adviento tienen un significado más profundo:

- El **Primer Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Esperanza con la "Vela del Profeta" recordándonos que Jesús viene.
- El **Segundo Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Fe con la "Vela de Belén" que nos recuerda el viaje de María y José a Belén.
- El **Tercer Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Alegría con la "Vela del Pastor", recordándonos la alegría que experimenta el mundo en la proximidad del nacimiento de Jesús.
