The Parish will provide chips and dips, and we invite you to bring a favorite dish to share that is Mardi Gras or ethnically inspired. 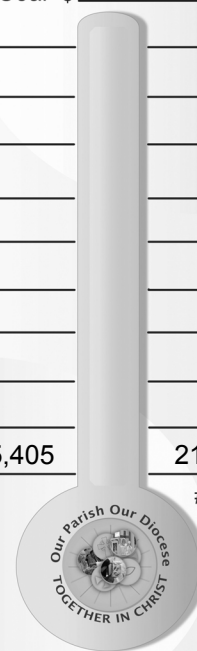
