WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

Obedience: This virtue has become one of my favorites. I am always reminded that obedience is an act of love and not of servile slavery. When we choose to obey, we seek to see the very best in who is asking us to do something. We choose to trust the other is seeking to help us be a better person.

Bringing the intention into your family/

relationships: Talking about hopes and dream for the future is important. What are your hopes and dreams for your child? Do you share them? Are first hope and dream should always be the holiness and joy of the family and each member to fulfill their lives in following God.

Discussion starter: How does obedience help me to be a better person? What dreams do I have for holiness?

Spiritual Bouquet: Write a letter to your children expressing your dreams for their lives, not just what they will do but how they will fulfill their lives as God's child.

TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN PARA LA ORACIÓN

La primera esperanza y el sueño siempre debe ser la santidad y la alegría de la familia y de cada miembro para cumplir sus vidas al seguir a Dios.

Iniciador de discusión: ¿Cómo me ayuda la obediencia a ser una mejor persona? ¿Qué sueños tengo para la santidad?

Ramo espiritual: Escriba una carta a sus hijos expresando sus sueños para sus vidas, no solo lo que harán sino cómo cumplirán sus vidas como hijos de Dios.
