
A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Last week, parishes throughout the diocese began to share to good news about how we can support the greater mission of our Catholic Church and our Bishop Patrick through sharing our gifts of time, talent and treasure.

The Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA) is about sharing our treasure so others in the Diocese of San Jose can share their talents to evangelize our growing community. It is a yearly task that we undertake and it should be a task of joy and blessing. And yet, we find it hard to celebrate this opportunity for generosity in our lives. Why is that?

As we have been reading Resisting Happiness we can begin to understand our reluctance at time to share in the generosity of God's blessing. In Chapter 8 "Four Words" Matthew Kelly shares with us why it is sometimes hard to connect with God...we think of him as "far away," distant and remote from our lives. RCIA 101: Why are there adults being “dismissed” during Mass before the Liturgy of the Eucharist?

As we prepare to enter into the Lent & Easter Season, those who are not yet baptized are “dismissed” after the homily. They walk out with a Team Member and go to another room where they break open the Readings, Gospel and Homily and are “feeding off the Word”. Since they cannot yet receive Holy Communion (remember they’re not yet baptized) they are not missing the Liturgy of the Eucharist but their hearts are filling with a deeper yearning and excitement in anticipation of their Initiation into the Catholic Church.

The Race Was Won, at "Amazing Race" Middle School Retreat

Parishes from the Diocese of San Jose teamed up for a Middle School Retreat On January 28-29, 73 middle school students from 6 different parishes experienced an overnight retreat at Camp Maymac in Felton, CA. The parishes included St. Catherine, St. Lucy, St. Martin of Tours, Sacred Heart, Queen of Apostles from DSJ and St. Joseph Basilica Parish from Alameda. The retreat theme was "The Amazing Race", with sessions entitled "Mental Prep",



"Endurance", "Hydrate", and "Nutrition". The coordinators of the retreat, Youth Ministers from 8 different parishes, were inspired by St. Paul's writings - "Do you not know that the runners in the stadium all run in the race, but only one wins the prize? Run so as to win. Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one" 1 Corinthians 9:24-25. The session speakers used the example of a runner in a race to emphasize what is most important for the middle schoolers to know for their "race" to heaven. This included knowing God had a plan for them to be on the retreat, and that although being a disciple isn't easy, God gives His amazing grace to persevere towards the prize that lasts forever: His abundant love! Patty Osorio got to give the breakout session for the 6th graders and she was overjoyed at their energy and willingness to "stay in the race." At one point in the evening, the room filled with voices singing "Lord I need You" by Matt Maher as Deacon Matthew Murray processed around with the Blessed Sacrament to each person. In addition to the sessions, the retreat was packed with small group discussions, praise and worship, and whole lot of messy games (shaving cream, paint, corn starch, etc)! The retreat concluded with a Mass presided by Fr. Robert from Sacred Heart for the participants. It was such a success that the youth ministers are already planning on the next one. We hope to have tons of St. Lucy youth there!



Eucharistic Adoration for Vocations

Pope Francis said: "Behind and before every vocation to the priesthood or to the consecrated life there is always the strong and intense prayer of someone: a grandmother, a grandfather, a mother, a father, a community."




