A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Today our Catholic Church celebrates the Baptism of Our Lord. It is a day when each of us should remember our own baptism and who we are called to be by this baptism into the life, death and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church I would like to point out four important teachings about Baptism.

First: "Christian Parents will recognize that this practice also accords with their role as nurturers of the life that God has entrusted to them." (CCC 1251) Parents are the first and best teachers of faith and a faith filled home, a home filled with prayer, blessings and joy is the garden where children flourish and the Church takes root in their lives.

Second: "For all the baptized, children or adults, faith must grow after Baptism...For the grace of Baptism to unfold, the parents' help is important. So too is the role of the godfather and godmother, who must be firm believers, able and ready to help the newly baptize, child or adult, on the road of Christian life." (CCC 1254-55) Much like the first point, the formation of all the baptized, adults and children, is an ongoing and vital gift given and shared. (Continued on page 8...)

Hoy nuestra Iglesia Católica celebra el Bautismo de Nuestro Señor. Es un día en el que cada uno de nosotros debe recordar nuestro propio bautismo y quiénes somos llamados a ser mediante este bautismo en la vida, muerte y resurrección de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica señala cuatro enseñanzas importantes sobre el Bautismo.

Primero: "Los padres cristianos deben reconocer que esta práctica corresponde también a su misión de alimentar la vida que Dios les ha confiado." (CCC 1251) Los padres son los primeros y mejores maestros de fe y un hogar lleno de fe, un hogar lleno con oración, bendiciones y alegría es el jardín donde los niños florecen y la Iglesia se vuelve parte de sus vidas.

Segundo: "En todos los bautizados, niños o adultos, la fe debe crecer después del Bautismo...Para que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse es importante la ayuda de los padres. Ese es también el papel del padrino o de la madrina, que deben ser creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana." (CCC 1254-55) Al igual que el primer punto, la formación de todos los bautizados, adultos y niños, es un regalo continuo y vital dado y compartido. (Continúa en la página 8...)

THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD

Last Monday, January 8th, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brought to an end the season of Christmas. The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus descended into the River to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God. The event takes on the importance of a second creation in which the entire Trinity intervenes.

Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happened at our Baptism. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted sons of God. At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened; at our Baptism heaven was



opened to us.

EL BAUTISMO DE NUESTRO SEÑOR

El pasado lunes 8 de enero, la Iglesia celebró la Solemnidad del Bautismo de Nuestro Señor. Esto puso fin a la temporada de Navidad. La Iglesia recuerda la segunda manifestación o epifanía de Nuestro Señor que ocurrió con motivo de su bautismo en el Jordán. Jesús descendió al río para santificar sus aguas y darles el poder de engendrar hijos de Dios. El acontecimiento adquiere la importancia de una segunda creación en la que interviene toda la Trinidad.

Muchos de los incidentes que acompañaron al bautismo de Cristo son simbólicos de lo que sucedió en nuestro Bautismo. En el bautismo de Cristo, el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre él; en nuestro Bautismo la Trinidad tomó su morada en nuestra alma. Si eres una pareja que han decidido regularizar su estado matrimonial o gustas explorar más acerca del beneficio de recibir el sacramento del matrimonio habla con el Sr. Antonio Ojeda. Aquí se enlistan los siguientes requisitos para ser presentados antes del matrimonio. (Si es católico; deben tener sus tres sacramentos de Iniciación: Bautismo, Comunión y Confirmación)

- 1. Certificado Bautismal:** Original y reciente y valido por lo menos 6 meses antes del matrimonio, la pareja presentará el certificado de bautizo, y/o primera comunión y confirmación. Si uno de los novios no es católico, tendrá que presentar una carta de afiliación a la religión que pertenece.
- 2. Testimonio Personal:** Los novios llenarán esta forma; Testimonio del testigo: Generalmente esta forma es llenada por un familiar o conocido del novio y de la novia Forma de dispensación: En caso de que uno de los novios no sea católico, él/ella promete que los hijos serán bautizados y criados como católicos.
- 3. Licencia de Matrimonio:** Deben obtener su Licencia Matrimonial (sino se han casado por el civil); por lo menos un mes antes de la fecha de la boda y deben presentarla el día del ensayo. Si la pareja quiere validar su matrimonio, entonces debe mostrar el certificado de matrimonio.
- 4. Certificado de preparación Matrimonial:** Requisito de asistencia al retiro de preparación matrimonial el 12 de Enero 2019 (solo por inscripción)

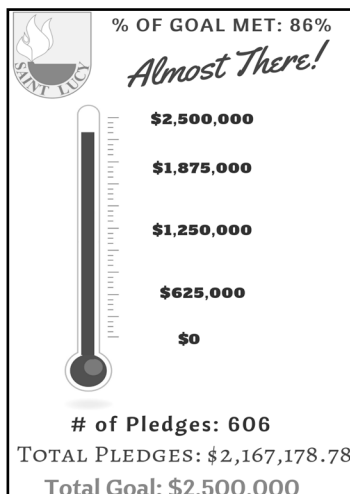

The parish offers many tools and opportunities to grow in our faith. Have you signed up for formed.org to help you and your family celebrate our Catholic faith.

Third: "Baptism not only purifies from all sins, but also makes the neophyte "a new creature," an adopted son of God, who has become a "partaker of the divine nature" member of Christ and co-heir with him, and a temple of the Holy Spirit." (CCC 1265) As daughters and sons of God, co-heirs in the kingdom, temples of the Holy Spirit, we are called to a life of grace and holiness. We are called from the ordinary to the extraordinary, from the mundane to the saintly. This is the invitation of Jesus to follow him no longer as servants but as friends. (Jn 15:15)

Finally: "Baptism incorporates us into the Church. From the baptismal fonts is born the one People of God of the New Covenant, which transcends all the natural and human limits of nations, cultures, races and sexes: "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body." (CCC 1267) We are reminded that our faith is not limited by sin and human frailty but is bound to the endless love and mercy of our God.

The question we are given: Do we live our life as disciples, friends and brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ?

La pregunta que se nos hace: ¿vivimos nuestra vida como discípulos, amigos y hermanos en Jesucristo?

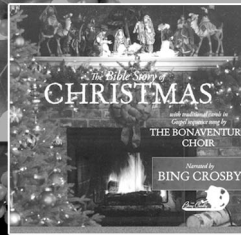
