“There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God.” (1 Cor 12:4-5)

One of the Corporal Works of Mercy we are focusing on this month is **Sheltering the Homeless**. This may seem like an overwhelming task when we first look at it as we ask the question: How is my family called to shelter the homeless?

As stewards of God’s gifts of time, talent and treasure we are all challenged to seek out the service of love that God invites us to share. Seeking the Kingdom of God is seeking the person of Jesus in those around us. Take time this week to pray about how you are called to share your gifts of time, talent and treasure as we ask the question, “How is my family called to shelter the homeless?” **God bless, Fr. 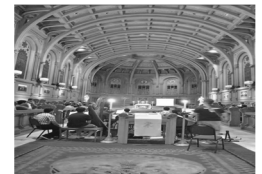
