Today, the first day of the New Year, the Catholic Church celebrates the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. For many of us this seems like a very simple statement to make but in truth it was a great and very contentious argument for the early Church and in some cases it is still being played out today.

We are called to in faith and reason to look at who Mary is in relationship to who Jesus is and then in hopeful understanding to integrate the blessing of the Incarnation of Jesus into how we are called to be like Mary in our lives.

In the Vatican II document, *Lumen Gentium* we proclaim, "the Mother of Jesus in the glory which she possesses in body and soul in heaven is the image and beginning of the Church as it is to be perfected in the world to come. Likewise she shines forth on earth, until the day of the Lord shall come, a sign of certain hope and comfort to the pilgrim people of God. (#68) (Continued page 2...)



Parent Faith Formation:



SOLEMNITY OF MARY, THE MOTHER OF GOD / LA SOLEMNIDAD DE LA VIRGEN MARÍA, MADRE DE DIOS

On January 1, New Year's Day, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Holy Mother of God. It is the highest title of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Theotokos, Mother of God. This title was given to Mary at the Council of Ephesus in 431 A.D. The council taught that the humanity and divinity of Jesus could not be separated and that they exist in one person, with the implication that we can rightly give Mary the title of Mother of God.





Our 8th graders are completing their Catholic High School applications


and studying for their High School Placement Test.
