It is in sharing the gifts of life that we encounter peace and love. In these encounters our hearts are opened to generosity as we share the true presence of God in one another. St. Lucy Safe Park

As mentioned in last week's bulletin, on November 21, 2016 we officially began the St. Lucy Safe Park ministry. We are happy to report that 8 Safe Park guests are staying with us! Our program runs until March 1, 2017. Our Safe Park hours are Monday-Saturday 8:30pm-6:30am. We also provide access to our bathrooms in the PAC.

What are our next steps for this program?

One of our next steps is to make shower stalls available once per week to our safe park guests. This will involve a mobile-truck-mounted-unit that will be located on-site for a 24 hour period. The truck-mounted shower unit contains 4 to 6 independent showers with locking doors. Showers would be available between the hours of 7-9pm one day per week. The shower truck, provided by Casa de Clara San Jose Catholic Worker, is called "Showers to the People!" and is made available to the San Jose and surrounding area. There is no cost for us to have the shower truck visit us one per week. For more information see, www.sjcw.org under Programs or call 408-297-8330.

Secondly, we are planning on coordinating a potluck meal, once per week, to our safe park guests. Currently scheduled in the 7pm timeframe in the PAC. Volunteers on our ministry team are working on the details for this weekly meal service.

El camión, proporcionado por la Casa de Clara San José Catholic Worker, se llama "Duchas para el Pueblo" para uso en San José y sus alrededores. No hay costo para nosotros para que el camión de la ducha nos visite una vez por semana. Para obtener más información, consulte www.sjcw.org bajo programas o llame al 408-297-8330.

En segundo lugar, estamos planeando coordinar una comida de potluck, una vez por semana, para nuestros huéspedes. Actualmente esta programado a las 7 pm en el PAC. El equipo de voluntarios para este ministerio están trabajando en los detalles para ofrecer comida semanalmente.


