Welcome Fr. Andrey Garcia Bienvenido al Padre Andrey Garcia

Hello all. My name is Fr. Andrey Garcia Mariscal. Thank all of you for a warm welcome that you extended to me. So that we can know each other a little better, I would like to share something about me...

I am the youngest son of a generous family of 14 (fourteen) 12 of us remain alive, I have 5 sisters and 6 brothers. My dad lives in Zapopan Jalisco, where I was born and grew up. Well I did not grow much. When I was 11 years old, I lost my mom. she died of cancer. At the age of 16, I came to U.S.A. thinking to study English and go back to work as a tourist guide, but 29 years have passed and I am here, because God's plans were different from my plans. After being a bad-boy for some of my youth, I was almost killed for being a gangster, God gave me another chance and called me to the priesthood. Yes, from the streets to the altars.

I did my seminary studies in Washington, D.C in a missionary order IVE, Instituto del Verbo Encarnado. When I was ordained, I was sent to work in the Bronx, New York for 16 months, after that they sent me to Guyana, South America for a year, from there back to New York, this time Brooklyn, and from there, to here in San Jose. I was at St. Leo's for almost 3 years and after that I decided to get incardinated into the Diocese of San José. My first assignment in my transition to the Diocese was St. Julie's, from there to St. Catherine's with Fr. Mark, as my pastor, from there to St. John Vianney, to Sacred Heart, here in San Jose.

My hobbies are music and sports. Especially Soccer, so I hope you can invite me some time to play soccer.

Hola a todos. Mi nombre es Padre Andrey García Mariscal. Gracias a todos por la cálida bienvenida que me han dado. Para que podamos conocernos un poco mejor, me gustaría compartir algo sobre mí...

Soy el hijo menor de una familia generosa de 14 (catorce), 12 de nosotros permanecemos vivos, tengo 5 hermanas y 6 hermanos. Mi padre vive en Zapopan Jalisco, donde nací y crecí. Bueno, no crecí mucho. Cuando tenía 11 años, perdí a mi madre, murió de cáncer. A la edad de 16 años, vine a los EE.UU. pensando en estudiar inglés y volver a trabajar como guía turístico, pero han pasado 29 años y sigo aquí, porque los planes de Dios eran diferentes a los míos. Después de ser un chico malo por algunos años de mi juventud, casi me matan por ser un gánster, Dios me dio otra oportunidad y me llamó al sacerdocio. Sí, de las calles a los altares.

Hice mis estudios de seminario en Washington, D.C. en una orden misional IVE, Instituto del Verbo Encarnado. Cuando fui ordenado, me enviaron a trabajar al Bronx, Nueva York durante 16 meses, después de eso me enviaron a Guyana, Sudamérica durante un año, de allí a Nueva York, esta vez a Brooklyn, y de allí, aquí a San José. Estuve en St. Leo the Great durante casi 3 años y después decidí entrar en la Diócesis de San José. Mi primera asignación en mi transición a la Diócesis fue en St. Julie's y de allí a St. Catherine's con el Padre Mark, como mi párroco. De allí a St. John Vianney y luego a el Sagrado Corazón, aquí en San José.

Mis pasatiempos son la música y los deportes. Especialmente el futbol soccer, así que espero que puedas invitarme en algún momento para jugar al fútbol.

WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

Gentleness: "He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young." (Is 40:11) Gentleness is close to the heart in the love of another. To be gentle is to be attentive to the wounds that need healing and the hurts that need forgiven.

Bringing the intention into your family/ relationships: Gentleness is both actions and words. If you are able, show a video of you (parents) holding your children when they were just babies and have them describe this gentleness.

Discussion starter: How does gentleness express itself in our family? With our friends? What is a gentle word we would use to describe a family member?

Spiritual Bouquet: Make a list of gentle words to describe the virtue in your children and share it with them.

TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN PARA LA ORACIÓN

Gentileza: "Viene como un pastor que cuida su rebaño; levanta los corderos en sus brazos, los lleva junto al pecho y atiende con cuidado a las recién paridas". (Is 40:11) La gentileza está cerca al corazón en el amor a otro. Ser gentil es estar atento a las heridas que necesitan curación y las heridas que necesitan perdón.

Llevando la intención a su familia / relaciones: La gentileza es tanto acciones como palabras. Si puede, muestre un video de usted (padres) sosteniendo a sus hijos cuando solo eran bebés y pídeles que describan esta gentileza.

Iniciador de discusión: ¿Cómo se expresa la gentileza en nuestra familia? ¿Con nuestros amigos? ¿Cuál es una palabra amable que usaríamos para describir a un miembro de la familia?

Ramo espiritual: Haga una lista de palabras amables para describir la virtud en sus hijos y compártala con ellos.

PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU ATTEND OUTDOOR MASS:

1. If you are sick or are at risk because of age or other conditions, consider staying home.
2. We will continue to stream daily Mass and Sunday Masses.
3. Mass will be celebrated in the courtyard. Please park in the lot next to the courtyard (the teacher's lot)
4. Since we are limited to only 25 people, you will need to reserve or book your place at a particular Mass. Please have your ticket ready to facilitate your entry.
5. When you book your place please consider that even as some of you would like to come to Mass every day, we need to make it possible for others to participate in the Eucharist. That is why we are asking you not to reserve a place for yourself every day.
6. During the celebration of Mass, the use of a facemask is mandatory. We will continue to practice social distancing.
7. The manner you will receive Holy Communion will be explained at the beginning of each Mass.
8. We realize that many of you would like to participate especially in Sunday Mass; We would like to remind you that Bishop Cantú has dispensed all from the obligation to celebrate Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. During this time, you may participate at Mass on any day without concern for one's obligation.

PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU ATTEND DRIVE-IN MASS:

1. If you are sick or are at risk because of age or other conditions, consider staying home.
2. We will continue to stream daily Mass and Sunday Masses.
3. Mass will be celebrated in the back parking lot. Please enter from Winchester Boulevard. Look for parking volunteers wearing vests. They will direct you to your parking spot. Once you have arrived please turn off your engine. Engines will stay off for the entire Mass.
4. Since we are limited to only 100 cars, you will need to reserve a parking spot prior to coming to Mass. Please have your ticket ready when you arrive.
5. The manner you will receive Holy Communion will be explained at the beginning of each Mass.
6. When Mass is over, parking volunteers will assist you in exiting the lot. Collection basket will be available for you to drop off your donation as you drive out of the parking lot.
7. We realize that many of you would like to participate especially in Sunday Mass; We would like to remind you that Bishop Cantú has dispensed all from the obligation to celebrate Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. During this time, you may participate at Mass on any day without concern for one's obligation.

Volunteers: We are currently looking for a pool of volunteers that fit in the “non-vulnerable “ category (below the age of 65, with no pre-existing conditions) to help us in such tasks as prepare and clean the church before and after Masses and in organizing so we can maintain social distancing practices.
