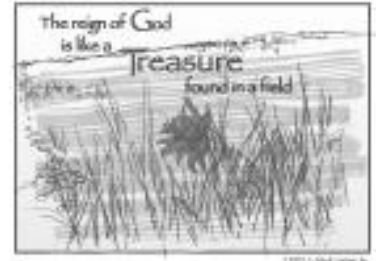

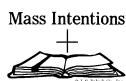
Cambios al Quiosco de Libros
