

Bishop Cantú Speaks on the Death of George Floyd

I echo the statement issued today by the US Bishops in the wake of the death of George Floyd: “We are broken-hearted, sickened, and outraged to watch another video of an African American man being killed before our eyes.” The senseless taking of life defies the fundamental principle of justice and respect for human life. We must recognize the fact that all lives are sacred. As Catholics, it is not enough to relegate our concern to only thoughts and prayers. Our church, at every level, must speak out unequivocally and work against the sin of racism.

As the US Bishops stated in their recent pastoral letter against racism, “Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love,” people of good will must never turn a blind eye when citizens are being deprived of their human dignity and even their lives. Indifference is not an option. They state: “It is not a secret that... attacks on human life have severely affected people of color, who are disproportionately affected by poverty, targeted for abortion, have less access to healthcare, have the greatest numbers on death row, and are most likely to feel pressure to end their lives when facing serious illness. As bishops, we unequivocally state that racism is a life issue” (p. 30).

We plead for an end to the violence in the wake of this tragedy. We support peaceful, non-violent protests and stand in support of those understandably outraged. We pray for comfort for all grieving families and friends. We applaud the majority of law enforcement officers who follow lawful protocol and demonstrate appropriate restraint, often in the face of threats.

As we approach the Feast of Pentecost, we plead for the strength and wisdom of the Holy Spirit. “With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, this wellspring of strength and courage must move us to act. Consequently, we all need to take responsibility for correcting the injustices of racism and healing the harms it has caused” (“Open Wide our Hearts,” p. 23). We challenge everyone, especially those from different cultural backgrounds, to come together peacefully to work toward a society where justice, peace, and charity may be shared by children of the same Creator.<http://www.usccb.org/issues-and-action/human-life-and-dignity/racism/upload/open-wide-our-hearts.pdf>

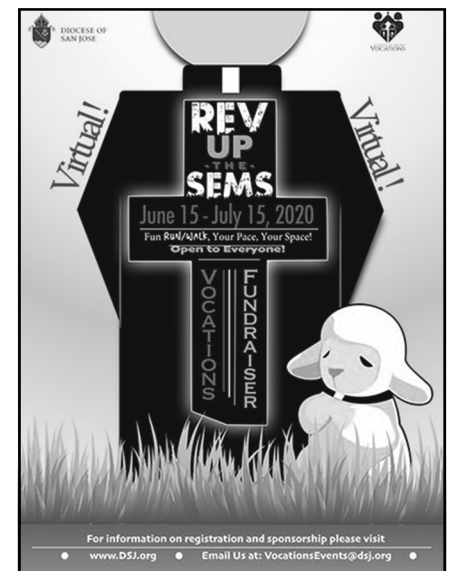

We are also called to continue to see the healing of God's grace in our life, family, community, nation and Church. Reconciliation, both sacramental and familial, are necessary in our journey of faith. With the racial unrest and the protest that in some cases have transformed into acts of violence, the Christian witness of reconciliation: listening, being with and seeking the good in each other is the path of a disciple of Jesus Christ. We must confront and speak truth to any act against the dignity of one of God's children where we desire to bring healing and hope into a world too often torn by hatred and violence.

WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

Forgiveness: "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Not much more needs to be said. Forgiveness must also involve reconciliation and healing. We are not called to forget the hurt of sin but are invited to let go and allow God to enter into the wound.

Bringing the intention into your family/relationships: Asking forgiveness is more than just saying, "I'm sorry" it is allowing the two people to sit down and talk about the hurt, the sorrow and the sadness that has occurred

Discussion starter: Talk about a time of healing and forgiveness in your life, both with family and with others, as an example. How did you feel when you were forgiven or when another forgave you.

Spiritual Bouquet: Sit down and share 10 minutes of just being with each other looking at the sunset or the clouds in the sky.

TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN PARA LA ORACIÓN

El Perdón: "Perdónanos nuestras ofensas como perdonamos a los que nos ofenden". No hay mucho más que decir. El perdón también debe involucrar reconciliación y curación. No estamos llamados a olvidar el dolor del pecado, sino que estamos invitados a soltar y permitir que Dios entre en la herida.

Llevando la intención a su familia / relaciones: Pedir perdón es más que solo decir "lo siento", es permitir que las dos personas se sienten y hablen sobre el dolor y la tristeza que ha ocurrido

Iniciador de discusión: Hable sobre un momento de sanación y perdón en su vida, tanto con la familia como con los demás, como ejemplo. ¿Cómo te sentiste cuando perdonaste o cuando otro te perdonó?

Ramo espiritual: Siéntense y compartan 10 minutos de estar juntos mirando la puesta de sol o las nubes en el cielo.

PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU ATTEND OUTDOOR MASS:

1. If you are sick or are at risk because of age or other conditions, consider staying home.
2. We will continue to stream daily Mass and Sunday Masses.
3. Mass will be celebrated in the courtyard. Please park in the lot next to the courtyard (the teacher's lot)
4. Since we are limited to only 25 people, you will need to reserve or book your place at a particular Mass. Please have your ticket ready to facilitate your entry.
5. When you book your place please consider that even as some of you would like to come to Mass every day, we need to make it possible for others to participate in the Eucharist. That is why we are asking you not to reserve a place for yourself every day.
6. During the celebration of Mass, the use of a facemask is mandatory. We will continue to practice social distancing.
7. The manner you will receive Holy Communion will be explained at the beginning of each Mass.
8. We realize that many of you would like to participate especially in Sunday Mass; We would like to remind you that Bishop Cantú has dispensed all from the obligation to celebrate Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. During this time, you may participate at Mass on any day without concern for one's obligation.

PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU ATTEND DRIVE-IN MASS:

1. If you are sick or are at risk because of age or other conditions, consider staying home.
2. We will continue to stream daily Mass and Sunday Masses.
3. Mass will be celebrated in the back parking lot. Please enter from Winchester Boulevard. Look for parking volunteers wearing vests. They will direct you to your parking spot. Once you have arrived please turn off your engine. Engines will stay off for the entire Mass.
4. Since we are limited to only 100 cars, you will need to reserve a parking spot prior to coming to Mass. Please have your ticket ready when you arrive.
5. The manner you will receive Holy Communion will be explained at the beginning of each Mass.
6. When Mass is over, parking volunteers will assist you in exiting the lot. Collection basket will be available for you to drop off your donation as you drive out of the parking lot.
7. We realize that many of you would like to participate especially in Sunday Mass; We would like to remind you that Bishop Cantú has dispensed all from the obligation to celebrate Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. During this time, you may participate at Mass on any day without concern for one's obligation.

Volunteers: We are currently looking for a pool of volunteers that fit in the “non-vulnerable “ category (below the age of 65, with no pre-existing conditions) to help us in such tasks as prepare and clean the church before and after Masses and in organizing so we can maintain social distancing practices. 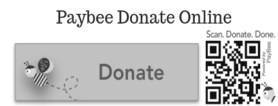
