## **Looking Toward Easter -- and a Season of Renewal (from the Pastoral Council)**

Over the last 18 months, our community at St. Lucy has been going through a process of reflecting on the ways that we work together as a parish to transform our lives though our relationship with Christ. As part of this process our "Parish Assessment and Renewal" or "PAR" leaders from across our parish ministries gathered on February 28<sup>th</sup> to look back on the ways the Spirit has been working at St. Lucy over the past 12 months.

In the upcoming edition of the St. Lucy Lamplighter, we will be sharing the richness that was shared during this "Gathering of Ministers" - a richness both of our existing ministries, and of opportunities for us to serve Christ together that are yet to be realized.

We are all called to be ministers of Christ in His Church and the world. As we reflect on our lives during this Lenten season -- and as we look to this edition of the Lamplighter -- let us do so with an eye to action. To which of St. Lucy's ministries am I called? Indeed, perhaps I am even called to create a new ministry for which we see a need. Whichever it might be, we can all be assured that the calling is indeed there.

### **Special Guest Speaker this Sunday**

#### **"Year of Faith" Series on the Second Vatican Council March 10, 4:00 - 5:30 PM in PAC**

Fr Frederick Cwiekowski is a Sulpician priest who has taught dogmatic theology at St. Patrick's Seminary for the past twenty-two years. He did his doctorate at the Catholic University of Louvain during the Council and studied under professors of the University who helped write some of the Vatican II documents.

The session will focus on Vatican II's *Dogmatic Constitution on the Church (Lumen Gentium)*. While the text stands in continuity with the Church's past traditions, it also presents significant developments in terms of our present understanding of Church, developments which challenge us still. Among others, we shall look at the understanding of the Church as the People of God, the dignity and role of all the baptized faithful, the universal call to holiness, hierarchy as service in the Church, and Mary as model and icon of the Church.




