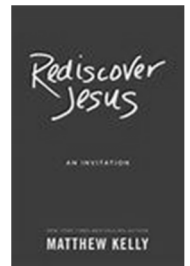

This can be a hard question on many levels, for many of us it exposes doubts that we often don't wish to share with others or even acknowledge in our thoughts. 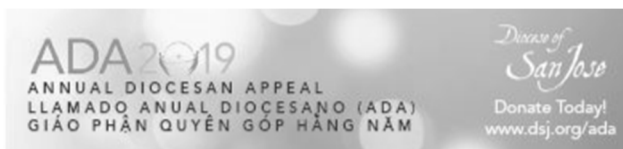

Encounter Norma



For young families living in the mountains of Guatemala, raising a baby can be difficult. Most families grow corn and beans for a living, but a long drought has reduced harvests. There are few job opportunities, which means that putting food on the table is a daily challenge. That's why, when Norma discovered she was pregnant, she wondered how she would manage. "When I was young, my mom and dad did not have the money to buy a lot of food," she says. "My mother would divide an egg among four children." Norma wanted more for her son, Victor. But at 20, he did not have much experience beyond helping his mother at home. Then, she sought help. She found it in a program sponsored by CRS that teaches young mothers how to raise healthy children, grow nutritious foods in small gardens and manage a healthy diet. In addition, CRS provided Norma with food during her pregnancy and monthly medical check-ups during the first two years of Victor's life.

"I learned many beautiful things," says Norma. "I learned how to take care of my son and what foods to give him so he can grow healthy and strong."

Now, Norma shares what she learned with others as a "mother monitor". "I am proud to share the experience I had and the lessons I learned with other women," she says. It makes Norma proud and makes her community a better place to raise a family.

Un encuentro con Norma

Para las familias jóvenes que viven en las montañas de Guatemala, criar un bebé puede ser difícil. La mayoría de las familias cultivan maíz y frijoles para ganarse la vida, pero una larga sequía ha hecho que las cosechas se reduzcan. Hay pocas oportunidades de trabajo, lo que significa que poner comida en la mesa es un desafío diario. Por eso, cuando Norma descubrió que estaba embarazada, se preguntó cómo se las arreglaría. "Cuando era joven, mi mamá y mi papá no tenían dinero para comprar mucha comida", dice. "Mi madre dividiría un huevo entre cuatro niños". Norma quería más para su hijo, Victor.



Pero a los 20 años, no tenía mucha experiencia más allá de ayudar a su madre en la casa. Entonces, ella buscó ayuda. Lo encontró en un programa patrocinado por CRS que enseña a las madres jóvenes cómo criar niños sanos, cultivar alimentos nutritivos en jardines pequeños y administrar una dieta saludable. Además, CRS le proporcionó alimentos a Norma durante su embarazo y chequeos médicos mensuales durante los dos primeros años de vida de Victor.

"Aprendí muchas cosas hermosas", dice Norma. "Aprendí cómo cuidar a mi hijo y qué alimentos darle para que pueda crecer sano y fuerte".

Ahora, Norma comparte lo que aprendió con los demás como una "monitora madre". "Me enorgullece compartir la experiencia que tuve y las lecciones que aprendí con otras mujeres", dice ella. Hace que Norma se sienta orgullosa y hace que su comunidad sea un lugar mejor para criar una familia.



BLACK BEAN SOUP

Makes 4-6 servings



- 1 T fair trade olive oil
- 1 green chili, diced
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 t ground cumin
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 2 t chili powder
- 2 c water or vegetable broth
- ½ t salt
- 3 cans black beans, drained and rinsed
- Cilantro, minced (optional)
- 2 tomatoes, diced

In a large pot, sauté onion and garlic in oil until brown. In a blender, combine 1 c water/vegetable broth and 2 cans of beans. Blend until smooth. Add to onion mixture. Stir in tomatoes, chilis, remaining beans, spices and remaining water/broth. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat, cover and simmer for 15 minutes. Serve

SOPA DE FRIJOLE NEGRO

Rinde 4-6 porciones

- 1 aceite de oliva de comer-cio justo
- 2 tomates, cortados en cubitos
- 1 cebolla mediana, picada
- 1 chile verde, cortado en cubitos
- 2 dientes de ajo, picados
- 2 t de comino molido
- 2 c de agua o caldo de verduras
- 2 t de chile en polvo
- 3 latas de frijoles negros, escurridos y enjuagados.
- 1/2 t de sal Cilantro,
- Cilantro picado (opcional)

En una olla grande, saltee la cebolla y el ajo en aceite hasta que se doren. En una licuadora, combine 1 c de caldo de agua / vegetales y 2 latas de frijoles. Mezclar hasta que esté suave. Añadir a la mezcla de cebolla. Agregue los tomates, los chiles, los frijoles restantes, las especias y el agua / caldo restante. Llevar a hervir. Reduzca el fuego, cubra y cocine a fuego lento durante 15 minutos. Servir

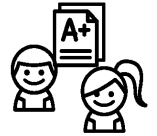

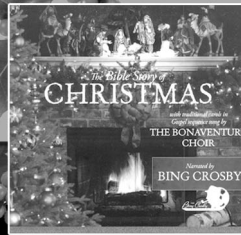
