## Home and Family with Trinh

For Trinh, home is where her family gathers—to play, to eat, to rest. “My family is the most important thing to me,” she says.

One way she shows her family love is by doing chores around the house. She helps her family by bathing her little sister, Trang, showing her how to wash her hands and helping her with schoolwork.

Trinh likes washing the teapot and cups and collecting eggs from the ducks. Often, Trinh will ride her bike to get medicine for her parents when they are sick. Trinh likes to catch dragonflies and crickets with her sister. Since her house is surrounded by rice fields, and coconut and bamboo trees, there’s plenty of places for the sisters to play. But the house is also near a river, and when storms pass through, Trinh’s home often fills with water. “I wish I would have a house that is not wet or leaky and would not flood anymore,” says Trinh.

In Vietnam, CRS is working with students like Trinh, helping them to learn ways to protect their home, food and family from destructive storms. Trinh is happy that she can apply what she learned in school to help her family.

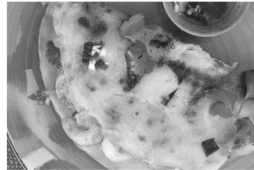

**For The Vietnamese Rice Flour Pancakes** Mix all pancake batter ingredients together in a large bowl until smooth. Let the mixture stand for 30 minutes while you prepare the other ingredients. **For The Vietnamese Dipping Sauce (Nuoc Cham)** Mix all the dipping sauce ingredients. Set aside. **To Prepare the Filling** Preheat a 9 inch, non-stick skillet with a lid over medium heat. Add the bean sprouts and cook until most of the moisture has evaporated. Remove the sprouts from the pan and set aside. Increase the heat to medium high. Add 1 tsp of oil to the skillet. Add the shrimp and cook for 2-3 minutes, until cooked through. Add the scallions and sauté for 1-2 minutes. Remove the mixture from the pan and set aside. **To Make the Pancakes** Add ½ tsp of oil to the skillet (if it looks dry) and pour about ½ c of the batter into the hot pan, tilting the pan quickly to create an even layer of batter that coats the pan. Distribute some of the cooked filling and bean sprouts over half of the batter and cover the skillet for 2-3 minutes, until the edges begin to brown. Remove the lid and reduce the heat to medium, cooking until the bottom of the pancake is crispy, 3-5 minutes. Once the bottom of the pancake is golden and crispy, fold the pancake in half over the filling. Transfer to a plate and serve. Continue with the remaining batter and filling, adding a little oil as needed before pouring the batter.

**Para los panqueques de harina de arroz vietnamita** Mezcle todos los ingredientes de la masa de panqueques en un tazón grande hasta que quede suave. Deja que la mezcla repose durante 30 minutos mientras preparas los demás ingredientes. Para la salsa de inmersión vietnamita (Cham Nuoc) Mezcle todos los ingredientes de la salsa de inmersión. Dejar de lado **Para preparar el relleno** Precaliente una sartén antiadherente de 9 pulgadas con tapa a fuego medio. Agregue los brotes de frijoles y cocine hasta que la mayor parte de la humedad se haya evaporado. Retire los brotes de la sartén y reserve. Aumenta el calor a medio alto. Agregue 1 cucharadita de aceite a la sartén. Agregue los camarones y cocine durante 2-3 minutos, hasta que estén bien cocidos. Agregue las cebolletas y saltee durante 1-2 minutos. Retire la mezcla de la sartén y reserve. **Para hacer los panqueques** Agregue ½ cucharadita de aceite a la sartén (si parece seca) y vierta aproximadamente ½ c de la masa en la sartén caliente, inclinando la sartén rápidamente para crear una capa uniforme de masa que cubra la sartén. Distribuya parte del relleno cocido y los brotes de frijoles sobre la mitad de la masa y cubra la sartén durante 2-3 minutos, hasta que los bordes comiencen a dorarse. Retire la tapa y reduzca el fuego a medio, cocinando hasta que el fondo del panqueque esté crujiente, 3-5 minutos. Una vez que el fondo del panqueque esté dorado y crujiente, dobla el panqueque por la mitad sobre el relleno. Transfiera a un plato y sirva. Continúe con la masa restante y el relleno, agregando un poco de aceite según sea necesario antes de verter la masa.

### Divine Mercy Sunday

In 2000, Saint Pope John Paul II declared the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday – which is on 4/19/2020 this year. He granted a plenary indulgence to the faithful who observe this day of intense devotion.

**What is a Plenary Indulgence?** A plenary indulgence can remove all temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven if required conditions are met. "(Plenary Indulgence) is nothing less than the equivalent of a complete renewal of baptismal grace in the soul." Robert Stackpole, the director of the John Paul II Institute of Divine Mercy has stated.

Conditions required for receiving a Plenary Indulgence:

1. Sacramental confession 7 days before or 7 days after Divine Mercy Sunday
2. Receiving Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday
3. Praying for the intentions of the Pope – with the Lord's Prayer, or a Hail Mary or a prayer of your choice.
4. In any church or chapel, in a spirit completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin:
  - Take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy.
  - Or, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to Jesus (e.g. "Jesus, I trust in you!")

The best part is you can either obtain the plenary indulgence for our self or for the soul of a departed one. Imagine what a wonderful blessing it is to offer a departed soul the gift of Eternal life!


