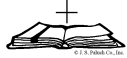



If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!"** (Mt 6:22-23)

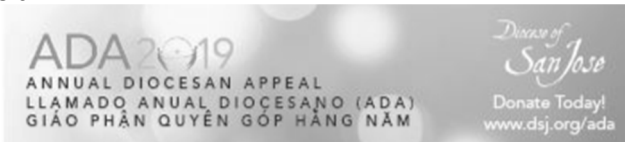

Encounter Christyan

Christyan DhathCroos is from a farming village in Sri Lanka, but he spent half of his life in India. He and his family fled there during Sri Lanka's civil war. He was only 14 years old when they left. When he returned to his homeland 16 years later, Christyan was 30, and the family farm was in shambles. He and his father found their fields covered in trees and filled with rocks. Now with a wife and family to provide for, Christyan needed help.

For a refugee, returning home after so many years can be challenging. That's why CRS is helping Christyan and others like him rebuild their lives. That means helping to clear overgrown sections of farmland and ensuring those farms have access to water. Christyan is now growing rice, pumpkin and peanuts. Because of the assistance from CRS, Christyan can give his family things he never had. Things like education. Because his family was always fleeing violence during the war, Christyan never completed school. "I want to make sure my three children are educated," he says. "That's my dream. No one in our family has finished their education, but I know my children will."

Christyan's dream is coming true. With the profits from the family's farm, Christyan can send his 4-year-old son, Godwin, to a private Catholic preschool. It's worth the money to Christyan to help Godwin achieve his dream of becoming a scientist. And there are no doubts from Godwin's parents or the Sister who runs Godwin's school that he will achieve his dream.

Christyan isn't just teaching his family that they can achieve their dreams with the help of a good education—he's also making sure they understand the importance of helping others. "When we had nothing, CRS came and helped us, and now we have what we need. We should help others too."

Un encuentro con Christyan

Christyan DhathCroos es de un pueblo agrícola en Sri Lanka, pero pasó la mitad de su vida en la India. Él y su familia huyeron allí durante la guerra civil de Sri Lanka. Tenía solo 14 años cuando se fueron. Cuando regresó a su tierra natal 16 años después, Christyan tenía 30 años y la granja familiar estaba en ruinas. Él y su padre encontraron sus campos cubiertos de árboles y llenos de rocas. Ahora, con una esposa y una familia a quienes proveer, Christyan necesitaba ayuda. Para un refugiado, regresar a casa después de tantos años puede ser difícil. Es por eso que CRS está ayudando a Christyan y a otros como él a reconstruir sus vidas. Eso significa ayudar a despejar zonas de maleza en exceso y asegurar que esas granjas tengan acceso al agua. Christyan ahora está cultivando arroz, calabaza y cacahuetes. Gracias a la ayuda de CRS, Christyan puede dar a su familia cosas que nunca tuvo. Cosas como la educación. Debido a que su familia siempre huía de la violencia durante la guerra, Christyan nunca terminó la escuela. "Quiero asegurarme de que mis tres hijos sean educados", dice. "Ese es mi sueño. Nadie en nuestra familia ha terminado su educación, pero sé que mis hijos lo harán". El sueño de Christyan se está haciendo realidad. Con las ganancias de la granja familiar, Christyan puede enviar a su hijo de 4 años, Godwin, a un preescolar católico privado. Vale la pena el dinero para Christyan para ayudar a Godwin a lograr su sueño de convertirse en un científico. Y no hay dudas de los padres de Godwin o de la hermana que dirige la escuela de Godwin de que logrará su sueño. Christyan no solo le está enseñando a su familia que pueden lograr sus sueños con la ayuda de una buena educación, sino que también se asegura de que comprendan la importancia de ayudar a los demás. "Cuando no teníamos nada, CRS vino y nos ayudó, y ahora tenemos lo que necesitamos. También deberíamos ayudar a los demás". "Mi esperanza es criar a mis hermanos", dice ella. "Y sé que puedo hacerlo con la ayuda de CRS y mi fe católica".



COCONUT DHAL

Makes 4 servings

- 2 c red lentils
- 2 T fair trade olive oil
- 1 shallot, chopped
- 1 shallot, chopped
- 1 garlic clove, chopped
- 1 t cinnamon
- Small handful dried or two fresh curry leaves
- 1 green chili, chopped
- 1 t hot curry powder
- 1 t salt
- 1 can coconut milk
- 2 c water



DHAL DE COCO

Rinde 4 porciones

- 2 tazas de lentejas rojas
- 2 cucharadas de aceite de oliva de comercio justo
- 1 chalote, picado
- 1 diente de ajo, picado
- 1 cucharadita de canela
- Pequeño puñado de curry seco o dos hojas de curry fresco
- 1 chile verde, picado
- 1 cucharadita de polvo de curry picante
- 1 cucharadita de sal
- 1 lata de leche de coco
- 2 tazas de agua
- 1/3 taza de jugo de limón


Rinse lentils. Heat olive oil in large pan. Sauté shallot and garlic until brown. Add lentils, cinnamon, curry leaves, green chili, curry powder, salt, coconut milk and water. Bring to boil, then reduce to simmer and cook until lentils are soft, adding more water as needed. Season with lemon juice. Serve with basmati rice and top with cilantro.

Enjuaga las lentejas. Calienta el aceite de oliva en una sartén grande. Saltea el chalote y el ajo hasta que estén dorados. Agrega las lentejas, la canela, las hojas de curry, el chile verde, el curry en polvo, la sal, la leche de coco y el agua. Lleva a ebullición, luego reduce a fuego lento y cocina hasta que las lentejas estén blandas, agregando más agua según sea necesario. Sazona con jugo de limón. Sirvelas con arroz basmati y adorna con cilantro.
