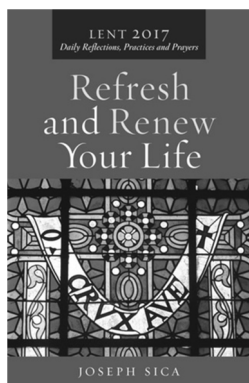

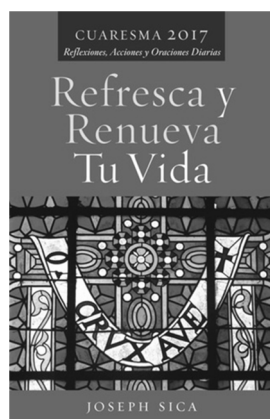

## Adult Faith Formation

### RCIA Retreat:

Last Saturday our RCIA Elect, Candidates & Sponsors spent the day reflecting on Jesus' words in Luke 9:23, "if you want to follow me you must deny yourself, carry your cross and follow me daily". They heard from Team Members testimony and had time to commit their life to Jesus Christ, see photo, below. We were blessed to have the Retreat at St Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park, where Eric Piczon was able to offer a tour of the facility.



### Scrutinies:

At the Masses for 9am on 3/19, 11am on 3/26, and 6pm on 4/2, our RCIA Elect (those to be baptized) will celebrate these rites on the upcoming Sundays of Lent. The Rite of Christian Initiation describes the "The scrutinies, which are solemnly celebrated on Sundays and are reinforced by an exorcism, are rites for self-searching and repentance and have above all a spiritual purpose. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful in the hearts of the elect [those preparing for the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and the Eucharist]; to bring out, then strengthen, all that is upright, strong and good. For the scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth and the life. These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all" (No. 141)

### The RCIA Scrutinies / Los Escrutinios del RICA

Today, during the 11 AM and the 1 PM Mass, our children and adults Elects (who are receiving the Sacraments of Initiation on this Easter Vigil) had their 2nd Scrutiny.

"The scrutinies, which are solemnly celebrated on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sunday of Lent are rites of self-searching and repentance and have above all a spiritual purpose. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. For the scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life. These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all." (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, article 141).

Either, if these rites are or they not celebrated at the liturgy we attend, they can be a good opportunity to reflect upon the journey that these Elect are making during Lent, as an inspiration and source of renewal for us in our own journey, and reflect on the need to examine (scrutinize) how we are, the areas of our lives where we are tempted, or seriously sin - in what we do and what we fail to do.

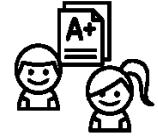
