Easter greetings and an invitation from the Pastor

The recent election of Pope Francis has been met with great enthusiasm and joy by Catholics around the world. He has impressed us with his humility and intense desire that Jesus Christ be known and loved everywhere. He wants the Church to follow the example of St. Francis of Assisi who lived his faith with simplicity and joy and who loved the poor and God's creation. From the crucifix in the ancient chapel of San Damiano in Assisi, the Lord Jesus spoke to St. Francis saying: "Francis, don't you see that my house is being destroyed? Go, then, and rebuild it for me." Pope Francis is inviting us to help rebuild the Church in our day just as St. Francis helped rebuild the Church of the 13th century.

As we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, let us pray and work for our own spiritual renewal and that of the world. The final document of the Second Vatican Council focused on such a renewal: The "Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World" (*Gaudium et spes*). 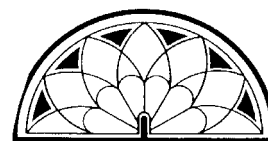

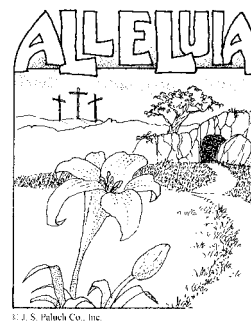
EASTER ENERGY

On Easter morning when the disciples saw the evidence of the Resurrection, they did not at first grasp it. John reports that “they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.” We, on the other hand, have both scripture and church tradition to teach us. Jesus Christ’s resurrection is at the core of our Christian faith.

All of today’s readings tell us how compelling this event was for the first Christians. There is great energy in all the readings. Peter preaches with authority and conviction. Paul calls for Christians to change their lives. In the Gospel reading we see Peter and John in a footrace to reach Jesus’ tomb and see with their own eyes the evidence that they still could not understand or completely believe.

How can some of this Easter energy be restored to us today? Do we let the astonishing news of the Resurrection touch us now? Does it call us to action? To deeper faith? To conversion? What new life will be reborn in us and our parish community this Easter morning?

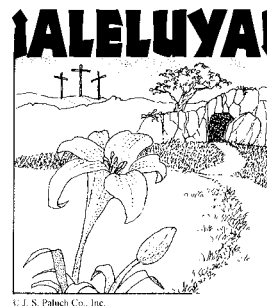
ENERGÍA PASCUAL

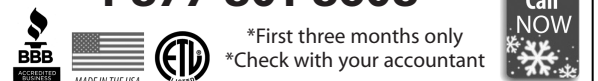
