### FROM THE SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY OF ST. LUCY

Have you ever felt powerless to do anything about a problem or concern that affects you or someone you know? (for example, the lack of affordable housing, health care, drug use, homelessness, unemployment, mental health services) Many others have experienced the same issues.

Individually, we have very little power to make a difference. Together with many others, our voices will have a much stronger influence in addressing the Social Justice issues and concerns within and beyond our Community. Here is an opportunity to get involved and make a difference.

The Industrial Areas Foundation (IAF) - the nation's oldest community-organizing network- is leading a large and diverse group of religious and non-profit organizations from San Mateo to Santa Clara counties to move beyond Charity toward Social Justice in order to address the root cause of the injustices facing our Community. St. Lucy's and St. Thomas of Canterbury parishioners are members of this broad-based organization. Together, we are known as the Bay Area IAF.

The Bay Area IAF will attempt to:

1. Build strong relationships and power within and across our communities.
2. Equip our members with leadership and organizing skills.
3. Act powerfully together on concrete issues facing our communities.

The mission of St Lucy's and St. Thomas of Canterbury group, similar to the Bay Area IAF, is to build relationships among members of our community and strengthen connections between people, which are the foundation for effecting real change. A core team consisting of St. Lucy's and St. Thomas of Canterbury members has been meeting and attending training to prepare and launch a community House Meeting. These are meetings of small groups where we will listen to each other as we share our stories and experiences, develop relationships, and discover talents and interests.

The common stories and concerns that are voiced in these meetings will set the agenda for the Bay Area IAF to work on as a community.

**Our first House Meeting is planned for March 17th from 3pm to 4:15pm in the Gym.** It is our goal to get participation from as many members from all groups within the parish. This would make sure we can identify all the varied concerns our parishioners have.

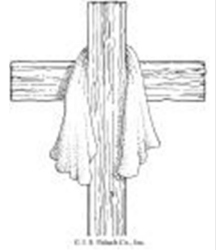

We are called to love our neighbor. This Lent, St. Lucy's community will participate in the CRS Rice Bowl—Catholic Relief Services' Lenten faith-in-action program, and we will be invited to reflect on how an encounter with our neighbor—as companions on life's journeys—can be transformative. We will see how our prayers, fasting and alms can support those worldwide who are forced to flee their homes to find safety or better opportunities.



The Rice Bowl boxes to collect money during the 40 day of the Lenten Season will be distributed this week. The money collected will go toward ending hunger both here in the US

and across the globe (through Catholic Relief Services). The program also includes activities that the families can do at home to practice almsgiving, prayer and fasting. In the last years, the CRS Rice Bowl also has benefited the St. Lucy's Outreach program of Saint Vincent of Paul who helps families in need in our community. **Don't forget to pick up your family's CRS Rice Bowl after mass.**

Please consider these suggestions in your family's Lenten plan:

- Use your CRS Rice Bowl to collect money that will go toward ending hunger both here in the US (including St. Lucy's St. Vincent de Paul program) and across the globe.

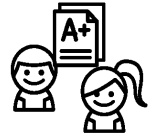

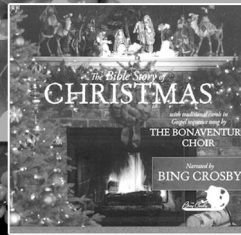
