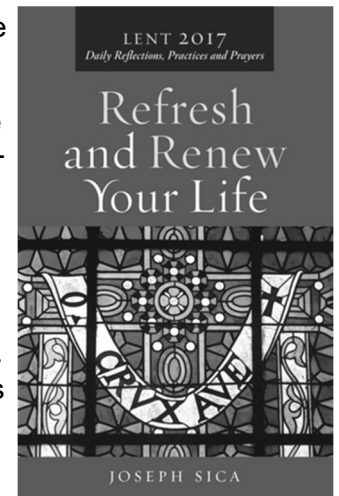

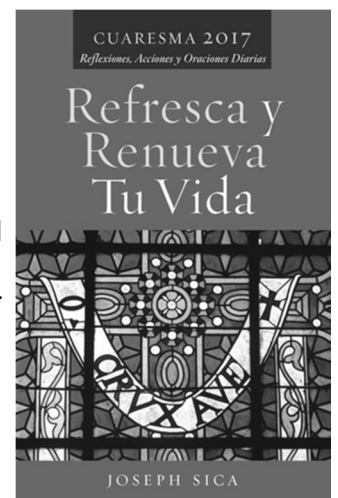

RCIA 101: Why are there adults being “dismissed” during Mass before the Liturgy of the Eucharist?

As we prepare to enter into the Lent & Easter Season, those who are not yet baptized are “dismissed” after the homily. They walk out with a Team Member and go to another room where they break open the Readings, Gospel and Homily and are “feeding off the Word”. 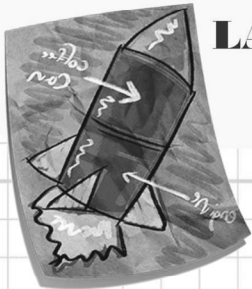

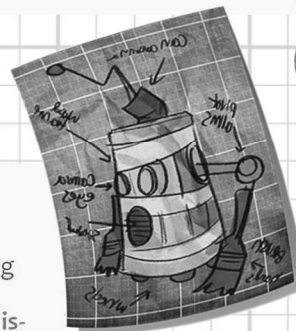

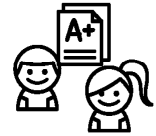
