Today is Pentecost Sunday when we celebrate the birthday of our Church as the Holy Spirit comes upon the Apostles and sends them, at Jesus' command, to go forth and spread the good news. 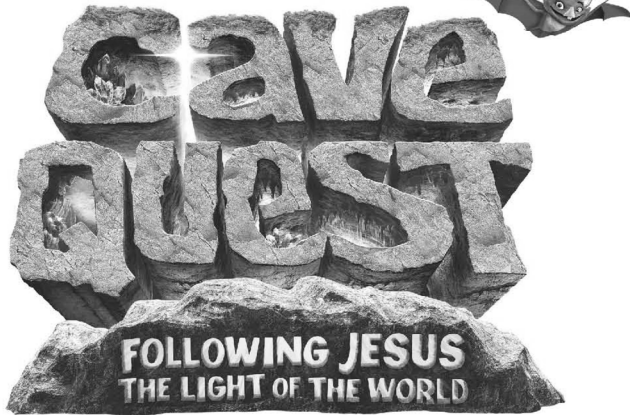
