SVDP/Outreach Corner

In early May Emma delivered the books she collected to two of the St. Lucy Conference members, Linda Kelly and Lawrence Cabral at our parish outreach office and food pantry. Rather than waiting to give the books out at Christmas time with our Christmas boxes we will be giving the books to those we serve when they come to our food pantry during the year.


