**SVDP/Outreach Corner**

**Books4Hope:** In March 2016, Emma Davis, an 8<sup>th</sup> grader at the St. Lucy School, asked if the St. Lucy Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul could use books for the children of those served by the Conference at the parish outreach office. 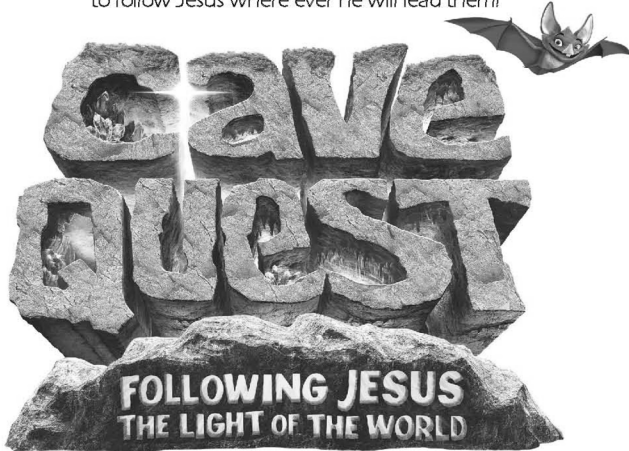
