2013 St. Lucy Annual Survey Results: The St. Lucy annual survey results are in! There were 817 responses - the highest response we've ever had to any survey! The results were overwhelmingly positive and there is strong support for the parish and the direction we are heading. The table below summarizes the responses to the survey statements. 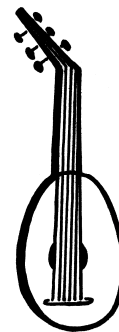
