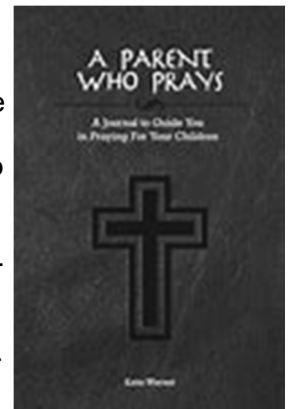

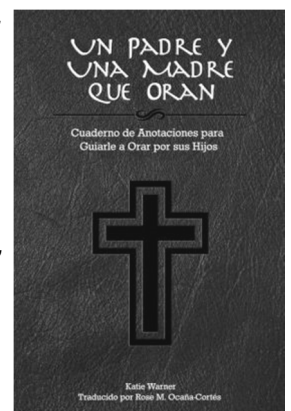


Comentarios del párroco



WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

Temperance: Temperance is the moral virtue that moderates the attraction of pleasures and provides balance in the use of created goods.... The temperate person directs the sensitive appetites toward what is good and maintains a healthy discretion. (CCC1809)

Bringing the intention into your family/relationships: For children (and adults) temperance and moderation can be difficult. This is where fasting is a healthy tool to strengthen the virtue of temperance in our lives. What will we fast from to strengthen temperance in family?

Discussion starter: Fasting is usually thought about as something for Lent. How can fasting be a good thing throughout the year? Can we fast from screen time?

Spiritual Bouquet: Share a story where you chose to let go of something in order to have a greater good.

TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN PARA LA ORACIÓN

Templanza: La templanza es la virtud moral que modera la atracción de los placeres y procura el equilibrio en el uso de los bienes creados. California Catholic Ministry Conference (CaCMC) Bulletin Announcement

Don't Miss Out -- Regular Registration Price for California Catholic Ministry Conference (CaCMC) Ends November 17. The California Catholic Ministry Conference will be held December 5-7 at the San Jose Convention Center. Attendees from all across California are expected to attend.

Beginning November 18, the price for the three-day conference will jump \$10.

Among the highlights of the 2019 conference are: in addition to Catechetical Formation there is also a focus on Social Justice, liturgy and leadership development. Region XI Liturgy Directors are leading a liturgical track and, liturgical publishers and artists are joining us for liturgical formation. Clergy formation is now a key part of the Conference this year focusing on preaching and presiding with Clergy formators being contacted across Region XI. In 2018, an additional day was added, Thursday, for day-long workshops sponsored by our partners in ministry. In 2019, two additional day-long workshops are added for a total of six.

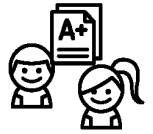
