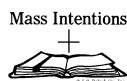

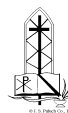

## Children's Faith Formation / Formación de Fe para Niños

### FIRST RECONCILIATION RETREAT

For the last two Saturdays the children of the Sacramental Preparation program and their parents attended a retreat focusing on the theme of Reconciliation.

Children learned that Reconciliation is a sacrament of healing in which our sins are forgiven and in which we are reconciled with God and the Church.

Jesus in his love and mercy, instituted the Sacrament of Reconciliation and He is waiting for us to forgive our sins.

During the retreat the parents and children shared their answers to the questions:

1. *What happened to me today that was happy?*
2. *What did I do that I could have done better?*
3. *What can I do tomorrow to make it better?*

We encourage all parish families to practice answering these questions at home to help their children to reflect on their day and how to make good choices.

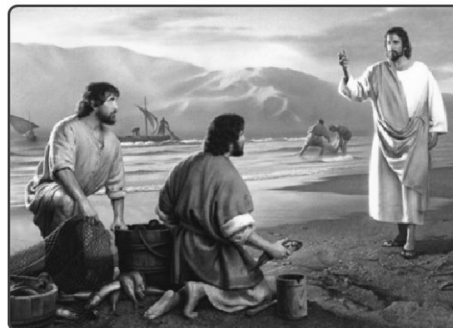

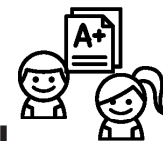
