## Drought Awareness

*“To build a world of peace and justice where each person can live with dignity. . . can be achieved if a world model of authentic solidarity prevails which assures to all inhabitants of the planet food, water, necessary medical treatment, and also work and energy resources, as well as cultural benefits, scientific, and technological knowledge.” (Pope Benedict, Angelus, 11/11/2007)*

During this time of continued severe drought, we at St. Lucy are doing our part to reduce water usage, so you may notice our lawns are less green and drier than usual as we enter our third month of cutting back watering frequency. We continue to research ways to reduce our use of natural resources in order to be a positive impact on our larger community. There are many ways we can all do our part to care for creation, and thereby each other. We encourage you to research and try practices that most effectively cut water and energy consumption in your own life. Here are a couple tips:

**Consume fewer material goods:** Did you know it takes about 2,900 gallons of water to produce one pair of blue jeans? So wear those old jeans with pride, either patched or torn! ([www.valleywater.org](http://www.valleywater.org))

**Consume fewer animal products:** Did you know it takes between 1,800 – 2,500 gallons of water to produce just one pound of beef? Eliminating meat from your meals just one day a week helps save water. Join millions of people around the country for “meatless Mondays” (or, do your own Catholic version and make it meatless Fridays). ([www.meatlessmonday.com](http://www.meatlessmonday.com))

## Ahorro de Agua en Santa Lucia

"Para construir un mundo de paz y justicia, donde cada persona pueda vivir con dignidad. . .se puede lograr con un modelo mundial de auténtica solidaridad lo que asegura que todos los habitantes del planeta tengan alimentos, agua, atención médica, trabajo y los recursos energéticos, así como los beneficios culturales, y del conocimiento científico-tecnológico." (Papa Benedicto XVI, 1.11.2007)

Durante este tiempo de la sequía severa, nosotros en Santa Lucia estamos haciendo nuestra parte para reducir el consumo de agua por lo que es posible que haya observado que nuestras plantas y el césped están un poco menos verdes, ya que reducimos la frecuencia de riego. Nosotros continuamos investigando maneras de reducir nuestro uso de los recursos naturales. Hay muchas maneras en que todos podemos hacer nuestra parte para cuidar de la creación. Los animamos a investigar y usar prácticas que reducen el uso del agua y el consumo de energía en su propia vida. Aquí hay un par de consejos:

1. ¿Sabía usted que se necesitan unos 2,900 litros de agua para producir un par de pantalones de mezclilla? Así que use pantalones viejos con orgullo. ([www.valleywater.org](http://www.valleywater.org))
2. ¿Sabía usted que se necesitan entre 1,800 – 2,500 litros de agua para producir una libra de carne de res? La eliminación de la carne de sus comidas un solo día a la semana ayuda a ahorrar agua. Hay millones de personas en todo el país que practican "lunes sin carne" (o, para hacer su propia versión Católica, sin carne los viernes).

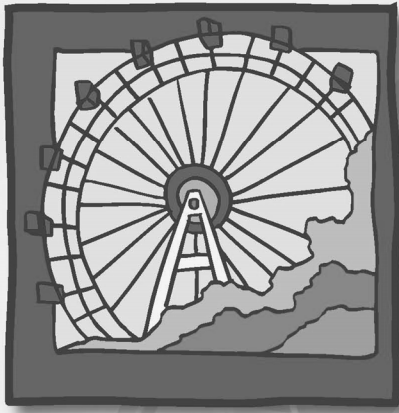

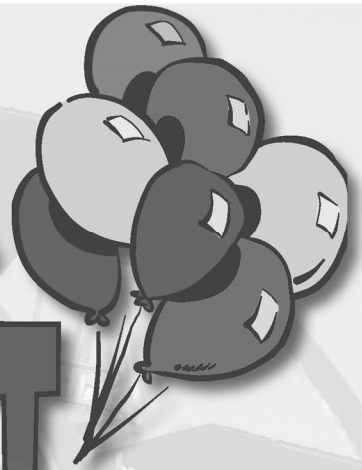
