Pope Francis' Top 10 List for Finding Happiness

1. "Live and let live." Everyone should be guided by this principle, he said, which has a similar expression in Rome with the saying, "Move forward and let others do the same."
2. "Be giving of yourself to others." People need to be open and generous toward others, he said, because "if you withdraw into yourself, you run the risk of becoming egocentric. And stagnant water becomes putrid."
3. "Proceed calmly" in life. The pope, who used to teach high school literature, used an image from an Argentine novel by Ricardo Guiraldes, in which the protagonist -- gaucho Don Segundo Sombra -- looks back on how he lived his life. He says that in his youth he was a stream full of rocks that he carried with him; as an adult, a rushing river; and in old age, he was still moving, but slowly, like a pool" of water, the pope said. He said he likes this latter image of a pool of water -- to have "the ability to move with kindness and humility, a calmness in life."
4. A healthy sense of leisure." The pleasures of art, literature and playing together with children have been lost, he said. "Consumerism has brought us anxiety" and stress, causing people to lose a "healthy culture of leisure." Their time is "swallowed up" so people can't share it with anyone. Even though many parents work long hours, they must set aside time to play with their children; work schedules make it "complicated, but you must do it," he said. Families must also turn off the TV when they sit down to eat because, even though television is useful for keeping up with the news, having it on during mealtime "doesn't let you communicate" with each other, the pope said.
5. Sundays should be holidays. Workers should have Sundays off because "Sunday is for family," he said.

1. "Vive y deja vivir." Todo el mundo debe guiarse por este principio, él dijo que hay una expresión similar en Roma que es el dicho "seguir adelante y dejar que los demás hagan lo mismo."
2. "Dese uno mismo a los demás." La gente tiene que ser abierta y generosa hacia los demás, dijo, porque "si se retira dentro de sí mismo, corre el riesgo de convertirse egocéntrico. "
3. "Vaya con calma" en la vida. El Papa, que solía enseñar literatura secundaria, utiliza una imagen de una novela argentina por Ricardo Güiraldes, en el que el protagonista - gaucho Don Segundo Sombra - repasa cómo vivió su vida. Dice que en su juventud fue un arroyo lleno de piedras; como un adulto, un río caudaloso; y en la tercera edad, seguía moviéndose, poco a poco, como una piscina "de agua". El Papa dijo que le gusta esta última imagen de una piscina de agua - tener" la capacidad de moverse con bondad y humildad, una calma en la vida".
4. Un sano sentido del ocio. "Los placeres del arte, la literatura y jugar juntos con los niños se han perdido, dijo." El consumismo nos ha traído la ansiedad "y el estrés, haciendo que la gente pierda una "sana cultura del ocio." ... la gente no puede compartir su tiempo con nadie. A pesar de que muchos padres trabajan largas horas, deben reservar un tiempo para jugar con sus hijos; horarios de trabajo hacen que sea "complicado, pero hay que hacerlo", él dijo, las familias deben también apagar el televisor cuando se sientan a comer, ya que, a pesar de que la televisión es útil para mantenerse al día con las noticias, tenerla encendida durante la hora de comer "no les permite comunicarse" unos con otros.
5. Los domingos deben ser días de fiesta. Los trabajadores deben mantener los domingos libres porque "el domingo es para la familia".




