The mission of Saint Lucy Parish is to lead people to a transformative relationship with Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church. We live our faith by welcoming and serving.

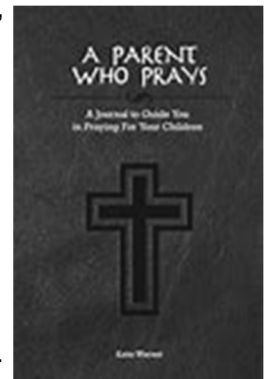

## WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

**Patience:** Let nothing disturb you, Let nothing frighten you, All things are passing away: God never changes. Patience obtains all things. Whoever has God lacks nothing; God alone suffices. (St. Teresa of Avila)

**Bringing the intention into your family/ relationships:** Prayer: the prayer of St. Teresa of Avila reminds us of how allowing God to be the center of the family brings gifts of patience. Prayer as family brings greater understanding. Humility: the simple grace of asking for help and talking about our limits is a grace given. Works: choosing to act in kindness when anger seems easier build courage and blessing .

**Discussion starter:** Make a list of those things we get most impatient with and share with each other. "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud" (1 Cor 13:4) How do we live this in our families?

**Spiritual Bouquet:** Share with each other a bouquet of patience, list some times you saw each member of the family practice patience with each other.

## TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN PARA LA ORACIÓN

**Paciencia:** no deje que nada lo moleste, no deje que nada lo asuste, todas las cosas están pasando: Dios nunca cambia. La paciencia obtiene todas las cosas. Quien tiene a Dios no le falta nada; Es suficiente con solo Dios. (Santa Teresa de Ávila)

**Llevando la intención a su familia / relaciones:** Oración: la oración de Santa Teresa de Ávila nos recuerda cómo, al permitir que Dios sea el centro de la familia, trae regalos de paciencia. La oración en familia trae una mayor comprensión. Humildad: la simple gracia de pedir ayuda y hablar sobre nuestros límites es una gracia dada. Al elegir actuar con amabilidad cuando es mas fácil generar coraje es una bendición.

**Iniciador de discusión:** Haga una lista de las cosas con las que nos impacientamos más y compártalas. "Tener amor es saber soportar; es ser bondadoso; es no tener envidia, ni ser presumido, ni orgulloso" (1 Corintios 13: 4) ¿Cómo vivimos esto en nuestras familias?

**Ramo espiritual:** Comparta entre sí un ramo de paciencia, enumere algunas veces que vio a cada miembro de la familia practicar la paciencia entre ellos.

### WHAT IS A CATECHIST? WHAT DOES A CATECHIST DO?

A catechist is a person of faith who leads others in understanding the teachings of Christ and the Church. The primary goal of a catechist is to model God's love to others. As a result, the primary requisite of a catechist is a love for God and a love for children. A catechist develops a lesson plan and uses that plan to teach in the classroom. By creating the lesson plan the catechist ultimately designs and structures experiences for students that help them grow in their personal faith and spirituality. The catechist passes on to students a set of shared meanings and values that are Catholic and Christian.

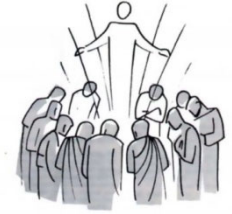

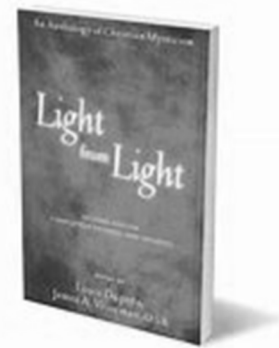

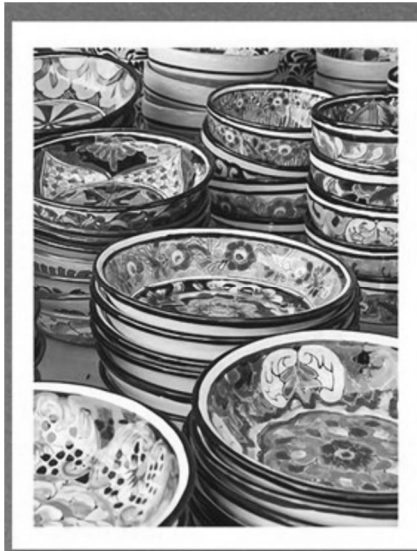
