We have made improvements to the lights in the immediate vicinity of the church to improve safety and security. All the lights at church entrances have been replaced with energy efficient, tamper-proof LED lights. New lights have been added to the front of the church on either side of the entrance to illuminate areas that up to now have had no lights. Lights have been added underneath and along the outside edges of the solar array to better illuminate the rear parking area. Finally, all the sensors and timers that control the after-dark lighting throughout the entire campus have been repaired and should all be working. 
### **Media Católica de Lighthouse**


