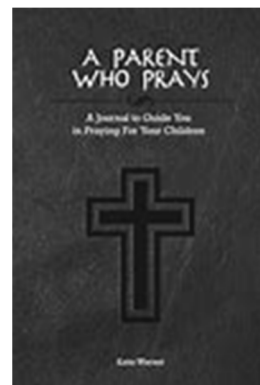

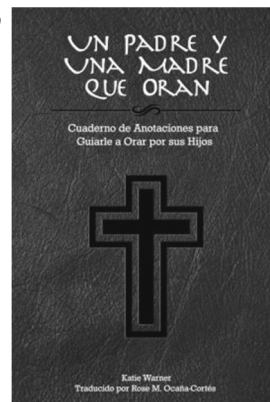


Gracias por venir a misa este fin de semana. Sé que con el Fun Fest y el impacto a nuestro estacionamiento, cada uno de us-

As we pray with Mary for the gift of humility we practice the gift of service in helping one another in action and in the world. As we write our spiritual bouquet for those we love we are also called to reflect on how humility is not the giving up of dignity but the recognizing how our vocation is one of caring for one another with hopeful joy.

We end the week with the celebration of the Memorial of **Pope St. John XXIII** who through humble trust in the Holy Spirit began what is now known as "The Second Vatican Council" or "Vatican II." In his trust of the movement of the Holy Spirit within the Catholic Church he asked, through the Council, for a renewal in the liturgical life of the Church. We have Pope St. John XXIII to thank for the richer diversity of readings we have at Mass today as well as the liturgy celebrated in our own language that were fruits of the Vatican Council.

WHAT IS A CATECHIST? WHAT DOES A CATECHIST DO?

A catechist is a person of faith who leads others in understanding the teachings of Christ and the Church. The primary goal of a catechist is to model God's love to others. As a result, the primary requisite of a catechist is a love for God and a love for children. A catechist develops a lesson plan and uses that plan to teach in the classroom. By creating the lesson plan the catechist ultimately designs and structures experiences for students that help them grow in their personal faith and spirituality. The catechist passes on to students a set of shared meanings and values that are Catholic and Christian.

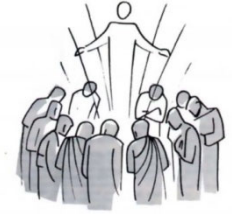

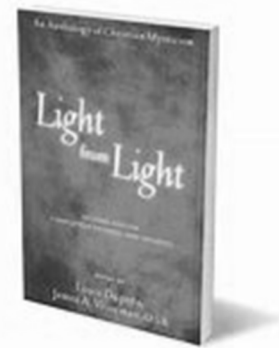
