LOOKING BEYOND OURSELVES

The message found in today's readings is an oft-told story. Citizen Kane, Daddy Warbucks, and King Midas are only a few of the familiar fictional characters who thought enormous wealth could buy happiness and fulfillment. Daddy Warbucks admitted stepping on a few people in his climb to the top. Kane tried to buy the printed word and stardom for his young wife, while King Midas conjured immense wealth and tragedy by his very touch.

We learn clearly in today's readings that none of this is really possible. True happiness comes from caring for someone other than ourselves. It comes from the pursuit of the virtues Paul described to Timothy: faith, love, gentleness, godliness, righteousness, and endurance. The Gospel reminds us that we dare not ignore the needs of others, acting as though we don't notice their suffering. God's call to us is much too clear to disregard for even one more day. El Evangelio nos recuerda que no osemos ignorar las necesidades de los demás, actuando como si no notáramos su sufrimiento. Children's Faith Formation / Formación de Fe para Niños



Do you know what the word "Catechesis" Means?

The word might be more familiar than you think. Many Catholics have used the word "catechism" for years, and they know it has something to do with the compendium of the Church's teachings. The root word, "catechesis," is from a Greek word meaning "to echo, or resound." Catechesis is the act of resounding or bringing the Church's teachings to the world. A catechist is a person of faith who leads others in understanding the teachings of Christ and the Church.

How is it that the parents are the first catechists of their children?

The National Catechetical Directory tells us that the parents are first and foremost catechists of their children. They catechize informally, but powerfully by example and instruction. Lorraine Amendolara writes in The Original and Irreplaceable Catechist: The Parent that "faith development begins in simplicity, with rocking, holding, feeding, listening, forgiving, comforting. These things that parents do every day become springboards of faith." The most powerful messages children learn are often times through wordless messages. Children watch in fascination the stories their parents are telling. The underlying theme of hope or despair, of graciousness or absurdity. It is in the everyday, common experiences that parents and children discover and develop their faith in God.

¿Sabe usted lo que la palabra "Catequesis" significa?

La palabra podría ser más familiar de lo que piensa. Muchos católicos han usado la palabra "catecismo" durante años, y saben que tiene algo que ver con el compendio de las enseñanzas de la Iglesia. La raíz de la palabra "catequesis," viene de una palabra griega que significa "hacer eco o resonancia." La catequesis es el acto de resonar o traer las enseñanzas de la Iglesia al mundo. Un catequista es una persona de fe que conduce a otros en la comprensión de las enseñanzas de Cristo y de la Iglesia.



¿Cómo es que los padres son los primeros catequistas de sus hijos?

El Directorio Nacional de Catequesis nos dice que "los padres son los primeros catequistas de sus hijos. Catequizar de manera informal, pero poderosamente con el ejemplo y la instrucción." Lorena Amendolara escribe en "El original e insustituible Catequista: Los padres" que "el desarrollo de la fe comienza con sencillez, meciendo, cargando, alimentando, escuchando, perdonando, reconfortando. Estas cosas que los padres hacen todos los días se convierten en trampolines de la fe." Los mensajes más poderosos que los niños aprenden son a menudo a través de mensajes sin palabras. Los niños miran con fascinación las historias que sus padres están diciendo. El fondo del tema de esperanza o desesperación, amabilidad o absurdidad. Es en las experiencias cotidianas, comunes que los padres y los niños descubren y desarrollan su fe en Dios.

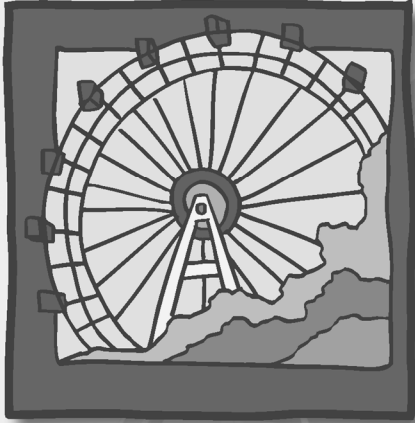

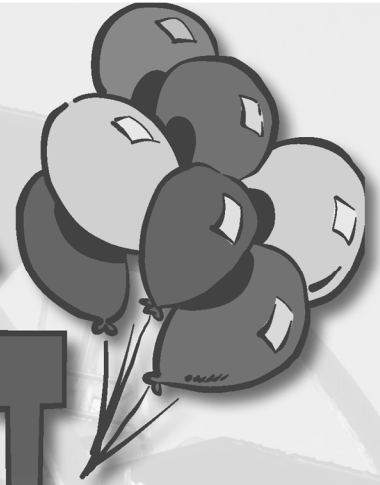
