

WEEKLY PRAYER DISCUSSION TOPICS

Peace: Jesus reminds us that the peace of God is different from the peace the world offers. The world's peace is the lack of conflict while the peace of God is to know we are in the eyes of God. To find true peace we must discover our true calling (vocation) in life. True peace is found in acts service, self-sacrifice and relationships of dignity. Like purity and faith it becomes a natural way of looking for God in our neighbors.

Bringing the intention into your family/ relationships: Peace is found in the healing of hurts in the family and or relationships. Is avoiding conflict more important than confronting sin and hurt in the family? What is one area in our family where we can be more "peaceful"?

Discussion starter: Pray the "Prayer of St. Francis" and then go line by line asking how each of the petitions in the prayer can help the family become "instruments of peace"
Learn about St. Edgar the Peaceful or other saints known for promoting peace.

Spiritual Bouquet: Share your prayers for a peaceful heart with members of your family. Talk about how you see peace in one another.

ORACION SEMANAL TEMAS DE DISCUSIÓN

Paz: Jesús nos recuerda que la paz de Dios es diferente a la paz que ofrece el mundo. La paz del mundo es la falta de conflicto, mientras que la paz de Dios es saber que estamos en los ojos de Dios. Para encontrar la verdadera paz debemos descubrir nuestra verdadera vocación en la vida. La verdadera paz se encuentra en los actos de servicio, el sacrificio personal y las relaciones con dignidad. Al igual que la pureza y la fe, se convierte en una forma natural de buscar a Dios en nuestros vecinos.

Llevando la intención a su familia / relaciones: la paz se encuentra en la curación de heridas en la familia y / o las relaciones. ¿Evitar conflictos es más importante que enfrentar el pecado y el dolor en la familia? ¿Cuál es un área en nuestra familia donde podemos ser más "pacíficos"?

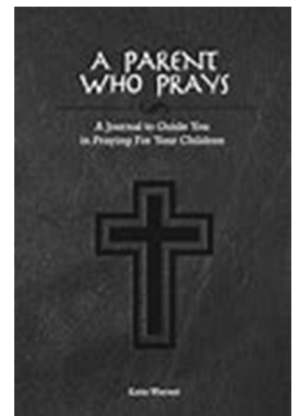

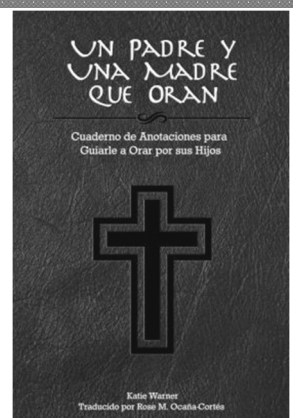

BAPTISM, THE FIRST SACRAMENT OF INITIATION

In his Apostolic Letter *Porta Fidei* (Door of Faith), which inaugurated the Year of Faith in 2011, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI began with these words: "The 'door of faith' is always open for us, ushering us into the life of communion with God and offering entry into his Church. To enter through that door is to set out on a journey that lasts a lifetime. It begins with baptism through which we can address God as Father,..." The Catechism states that, "Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission." Do you know what day you were baptized? What is the name of the Church where you were baptized?

Here at St. Lucy's, we have many children whose parents bring to our catechetical programs. These parents are fulfilling the promises they made when their children were baptized to form them into their faith. Also, we have school age children whom will receive their baptism during Easter Vigil, 2020.

EL BAUTISMO, EL PRIMER SACRAMENTO DE INICIACION

En la carta apostólica *Porta Fidei* (puerta de la fe), que inauguró el Año de la Fe en 2011, el Papa Emérito Benedicto XVI comenzó con estas palabras: "La 'puerta de la fe' está siempre abierta para nosotros, marcando el comienzo en la vida de comunión con Dios y ofreciendo la entrada en su Iglesia. Entrar por esa puerta es embarcarse en un viaje que dura toda la vida. Se inicia con el bautismo a través del cual podemos dirigirnos a Dios como Padre, ..." El Catecismo afirma que, "Por el Bautismo somos liberados del pecado y renacemos como hijos de Dios; llegamos a ser miembros de Cristo, incorporados a la Iglesia y llegamos a ser partícipes de su misión. ¿Sabe usted que día fue bautizado? ¿Cuál es el nombre de la Iglesia donde fue bautizado?"

Aquí en Santa Lucía, tenemos a muchos niños cuyos padres los traen a nuestros programas de catequesis. Estos padres están cumpliendo con las promesas que hicieron cuando sus hijos fueron bautizados de formarlos en la fe. Además, tenemos niños de edad escolar que van a recibir su bautismo en la Vigilia Pascual de 2020.
