Fr. Kevin's Report #3 from August 17

"Forming Intentional Disciples" Retreat: Changing the Culture of Silence





The retreat was based on a superb book: *Forming Intentional Disciples: The Path to Knowing and Following Jesus* by Sherry A. Wedell (Our Sunday Visitor, Inc.). The purpose of the retreat was to help parishioners involved in faith formation ministries to evangelize and to form "**intentional disciples**" in all our parish ministries. We don't simply drift into being a disciple of Jesus Christ. We have to make a decision to accept Him as Lord and to live according his teachings. That decision makes a HUGE difference. Research shows that churches which evangelize their youth help teens develop a positive, hopeful spirit, live out a life of service, and live a Christian moral life.

Pope Paul VI said: "In the long run, is there any other way of handing on the Gospel than by transmitting to another person one's **personal experience of faith**?" In our parish we need to speak about our experience of God and tell people how following Jesus Christ affects our life.

However, before the apostles were sent to evangelize they had to spend time with Jesus establishing a personal relationship with him. The same is required of us. We have to "be with" Jesus, to abide with him in prayer and meditate on His Word. With this foundation, "evangelization is no more than an invitation to enter into the mystery of communion with Christ" (Benedict XVI). In other words, the fundamental work of evangelization is to invite people to know Jesus Christ and to enter into a close personal friendship with Him.

We should ask people: "Tell me about your lived relationship with God." Then listen to where they might be in their faith journey. Ask good questions to help you understand. For example, If they say they don't believe in God, say something like "Tell me about the God you don't believe in." Chances are that you don't believe in that "god" either. Share your own experience of Jesus Christ. "Many people perceive Christianity as something institutional rather than as an encounter with Christ which explains why they don't see it as a source of joy." (Benedict XVI).

Homework Reflect on this question: How have you encountered Jesus Christ, and what opportunities does St. Lucy provide for encountering Jesus?

Reporte No.3 del Padre Kevin del Retiro del 17 de agosto "Formar Discípulos intencionales": Cambio de la cultura del silencio





El retiro se basa en un libro excelente: "Formar Discípulos Intencionales: El camino a conocer y seguir a Jesús" por Sherry A. Wedell (Our Sunday Visitor, Inc.). El propósito del retiro fue para ayudar a los feligreses que participan en los ministerios de formación en la fe para evangelizar y formar **"discípulos intencionales"** en todos nuestros ministerios parroquiales. No nos limitamos a ser un discípulo de Jesucristo. Tenemos que tomar la decisión de aceptarlo como Señor y vivir según sus enseñanzas. Esa decisión hace una diferencia enorme. Las investigaciones muestran que las iglesias que evangelizan a su juventud ayudan a los adolescentes a desarrollar un espíritu positivo, viven una vida de servicio, y viven una vida moral cristiana.

El Papa Pablo VI dijo: "En el largo plazo, ¿hay alguna otra forma de comunicar el Evangelio que por decirle a otro su **propia experiencia** con la fe?" En nuestra parroquia tenemos que hablar de nuestra experiencia con Dios y decirle a la gente cómo siguiendo a Jesucristo afecta a nuestra vida.

Sin embargo, antes de que los apóstoles fueran enviados a evangelizar tenían que pasar tiempo con Jesús, estableciendo una relación personal con él. Lo mismo se requiere de nosotros. Tenemos que "estar con" Jesús, para vivir con él en oración y meditar en Su Palabra. Con esta base. "La evangelización no es más que una invitación a entrar en el misterio de la comunión con Cristo" (Benedicto XVI). En otras palabras, la labor fundamental de la evangelización es invitar a la gente a conocer a Jesucristo y entrar en una estrecha amistad personal con él.



Debemos pedirle a la gente: "Háblame de tu relación vivida con Dios." Luego escucha en que etapa están en su jornada de la fe. Hagamos buenas preguntas para que puedan ayudarles a entender. Por ejemplo, si dicen que no creen en Dios, digan algo como "Háblame del Dios en el que no crees" Lo más probable es que usted no cree en ese "dios" tampoco. Comparta su propia experiencia con Jesucristo. "Muchas personas piensan que el cristianismo es algo institucional y no un encuentro con Cristo, lo cual explica por qué no lo ven como una fuente de alegría" (Benedicto XVI).

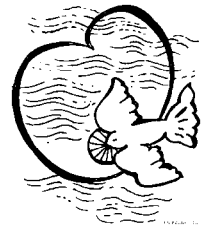

Collection Result Report

As mentioned in last week's bulletin, we are re-stating the collection results to correct an error in reporting. The best way to do that is to report how we did in the entirety of last year, and then show how we're doing thus far this year. In fiscal year 2012-13 (July 2012 through June 2013) we collected \$1,024,319 against a budgeted \$1,034,801. That's a shortfall of 1% or \$10,481. There are two important things to note: 1) we INCREASED our actual collections by \$165,175 over the prior fiscal year and we REDUCED the shortfall to just 1% of what we had budgeted. Another way of looking at it is that we increased our actual collections 19.23% in just one year. That is a tremendous achievement and testimony to the generous nature and community involvement of St. Lucy.

Now looking at this year, the below spreadsheet shows the budget, the actual and the accumulated results for this fiscal year. Please note that the ParishPay column reflects the actual income for July and August while September is estimated. Bear in mind that ParishPay income is monthly and must be divided by the number of weeks in a month to obtain the weekly ParishPay contribution. Since September is a 5-week month, the weekly ParishPay contribution is lower even though the monthly income will most likely be identical to July and August. As you can see, we started out a little behind but have caught up and are currently running \$3,408 ahead of the budget.

Informe de resultados de las Colectas

Como se mencionó en el boletín de la semana pasada, estamos re-afirmando los resultados para corregir un error en la información. La mejor manera de hacerlo es dar a conocer la forma que lo hicimos el año pasado y, a continuación, mostrar cómo lo estamos haciendo este año. En el año fiscal 2012-13 (julio de 2012 a junio de 2013) se recaudaron \$1,024,319 contra un presupuesto de \$1,034,801. Eso es un déficit de 1% o \$10,481. Hay dos puntos importantes: 1) Hemos aumentado nuestras colectas reales por \$165.175 dólares durante el año fiscal anterior y se redujo el déficit a sólo el 1% de lo que habíamos presupuestado. Otra forma de verlo es que hemos aumentado nuestras colectas reales por 19.23% en sólo un año. Esto es un gran logro y un testimonio de la generosidad y la participación de la comunidad de Santa Lucía.

En este año, la hoja de cálculo muestra el presupuesto, el actual y los resultados acumulados para este año fiscal. Tenga en cuenta que la columna de ParishPay refleja los ingresos reales para julio y agosto, mientras que septiembre es estimado. Tenga en cuenta que los ingresos de ParishPay son mensuales y deben ser divididos por el número de semanas en un mes para obtener la contribución semanal ParishPay. Debido a que el mes de septiembre tiene 5 semanas, la contribución semanal ParishPay es menor a pesar de que el ingreso mensual será probablemente igual que el de julio y agosto. Como puede ver, empezamos un poco lentos, pero hemos alcanzado y en la actualidad estamos \$3,408 por delante del presupuesto.
