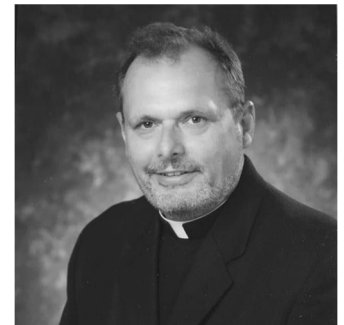

Many continue the pursuits of work that began after summer vacation while still others are initiating new projects that will continue until they are complete. Whatever may happen this year, may all we do be for the greater glory of God.

With each New Year, I am pleased to quote the memorable sermon my childhood pastor would repeat every New Year's Day for his homily message. Monsignor Mentasti would say "life is short, death is certain, and hell is forever; Think it over." It is no coincidence that this sentence may be found as the inscription on his grave marker. He was a good pastor, and when he preached on that day, he wanted the assembly to snap out of their complacency and come alive in Jesus.

This message may seem blunt yet makes us think about what is really important in life. Each of us is given the freedom of individual will, and it's clear that we can choose to make changes that will have a lasting effect long into the future. By sheer will, one can do many and great things, but most of us need a system to be more consistent. The human condition is not capable of willing happiness, love, or fortune. To cultivate these characteristics require us to plan and live in the moment.

We seek a wisdom that continues to resonate with all those who are spiritually attuned to virtue and truth. The act of becoming is the eternal call from God which sets our gaze toward the path of wonder and new life in Christ. Our ability to dream about the future is God's way of sharing a transcendent consciousness even while our waking hours are governed by definitive daily cycles. Throughout this new year, may God grant us the wisdom to discern our true path and the courage to follow.

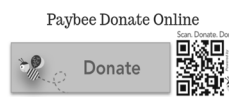

Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph celebrated on 12/30/2022 this year

The devotion to the Holy Family was born in Bethlehem, together with the Baby Jesus. The shepherds went to adore the Child and, at the same time, they gave honor to His family. Later, in a similar way, the three wise men came from the East to adore and give honor to the newborn King with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh that would be safeguarded by His family. Today's celebration demonstrates Christ's humility and obedience with respect to the fourth commandment, whilst also highlighting the loving care that His parents exercised in His keeping. Almost intuitively, one can recognize that the mysterious, exemplary, guardianship enacted by Joseph was conducted firstly, in a yet more intimate way, by Mary. Consequently, the liturgical feast of the Holy Family speaks to us of the fond and loving care that we must render to the Body of Christ. Looking at the Holy Family, we see the love, the protection, and the diligent care that they gave to the Redeemer. We can only ask the Lord, through the intercession of the Holy Family of Nazareth, for a greater love for their Son Incarnate, who has decided to remain here on earth with us every day until the end of time.

La devoción a la Sagrada Familia nació en Belén, junto con el Niño Jesús. Los pastores fueron a adorar al Niño y, al mismo tiempo, dieron honor a su familia. Más tarde, de manera similar, los tres reyes magos vinieron del Este para adorar y honrar al Rey recién nacido con regalos de oro, incienso y mirra que serían salvaguardados por Su familia. La celebración de hoy demuestra la humildad y la obediencia de Cristo con respecto al cuarto mandamiento, al tiempo que resalta el cuidado amoroso que sus padres ejercieron en su cumplimiento. Casi de manera intuitiva, uno puede reconocer que la misteriosa, ejemplar, tutela promulgada por José fue conducida en primer lugar, de una manera aún más íntima, por María. En consecuencia, la fiesta litúrgica de la Sagrada Familia nos habla del cuidado cariñoso y amoroso que debemos prestar al Cuerpo de Cristo. Al mirar a la Sagrada Familia, vemos el amor, la protección y el cuidado diligente que le dieron al Redentor. Solo podemos pedirle al Señor, a través de la intercesión de la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret, un mayor amor por su Hijo Encarnado, que ha decidido permanecer aquí en la tierra con nosotros todos los días hasta el fin de los tiempos.

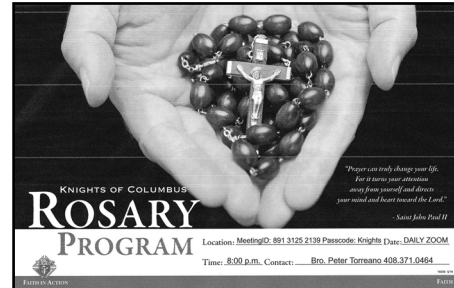

Today's readings include another account of the story of Jesus' birth. The reading from the book of Numbers reminds us that we are blessed. We are looked upon with kindness and grace. The psalm and Galatians remind us of the blessings given through God's Son. Luke tells of our ultimate blessing, that Mary, a human being like us, gave birth to a child who is God's Son. Mary, a young mother, watches all that is happening around the birth of her son. She listens as the shepherds bring messages from angels, a message she also received from an angel, about her son. Yet Mary remains silent. She keeps all this news about her son to herself. She reflects on all these experiences. The only thing she shares is the name of her son, Jesus, a name given him before he was even conceived. Her silence leaves us wondering if this is how one responds to such a great blessing.
